Settler Violence	6	-	6	Israeli settlers assaulted a resident in Beit Safafa village in Jerusalem, terrorised and threatened to assault several residents as they were collecting Olive harvest in Turmus'aya village in Ramallah, stoned vehicles and residents as they stormed Homish area and opened fire towards residents and homes Silat Al-Thaher village in Jenin, attached several residents as they were collecting Olive harvest in Deir Al-Hatab and Azzmout villages in Nablus and assaulted several residents near "Danial" settlement in Bethlehem.

<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On October 26<sup>th</sup> 2015, the Israeli army, continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound and prevented residents entering the mosque.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> <li>(iii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iv) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks.</li> <li>(v) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Sur Bahar with Cement blocks.</li> <li>(vi) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za’im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks.</li> <li>(vii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Wadi Al-Rabaybeh area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces considers Qalandiya checkpoint to be a border crossing point and only allows residents with Jerusalem Identification cards to enter the checkpoint.</li> <li>(ii) Since September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis and Shu’fat checkpoints and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to complete the construction of the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 11:15, Israeli forces set up five checkpoints at the entrances of Biddu, Al-Eisawiya village, Al-Tur, Jabal Al-Mukabir and Silwan neighbourhoods.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and clashed with several residents near Al-Quds University for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(ii) At 16:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village Dis and clashed with several residents as they summoned several residents to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At dawn on October 26<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained five residents: Ameer Al-Amouri, Yahya Nofal Zied, Mohammad Raja'I Taya, Ali Abu Diyab and Omar Ramzi Al-Za'anin.</li> <li>(ii) At dawn on October 26<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Jamza Mir'I in Abu Dis.</li> <li>(iii) On October 26<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained two residents: Ahmad Jibril Yacoub and Alaa Jibril Yacoub (Both residents of Al-Amari camp).</li> <li>(iv) At 20:25, Israeli forces detained Hisham Anwar Mohammad Al-Sha'rawi (A resident of Hebron) in Al-Eizariya.</li> <li>(v) At 20:30, Israeli forces detained the child Eyad Adnan Al-Rajabi (15 years old) in Silwan neighbourhood.</li> <li>(vi) At 21:00, Israeli forces detained two residents: Kamal Al-Lamam and Shadi Abdallah in Al-Sounat neighbourhood.</li> <li>(vii) At 22:45, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Nayef Obeid in Jerusalem.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Eisawiya village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(ii) At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iii) At 22:15, Israeli forces positioned near the North junction of Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child: Ahmad Mohammad Hillis (17 years old) leaving him hospitalised.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Physical Assault:</u></b> At 18:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Tur neighbourhood assaulted the child Yusef Mahmoud Al-Sayad (13 years old) leaving him hospitalised with contusions.</li> <li>• <b><u>Home Demolition:</u></b> At 13:00, Israeli forces stormed Sur Bahar village and served a military order for the demolition of a home owned by Shrouq Salah Duwiyat (A resident who is recovering from critical injuries after a Israeli settler opened fire towards her for allegedly attempting to stab a Israeli soldier in the old city of Jerusalem as mentioned in the report of October 8<sup>th</sup> 2015).</li> <li>• <b><u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u></b> At 11:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli military forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 19:30, Israeli settlers riding motorcycles stormed Beit Safafa village then assaulted Mohammad Eyad Othman Abu Shanab and as a result left him injured with contusions.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>QALQILIYA</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Roads:</u></b></li> <li>• Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.</li> <li>• In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</li> <li>• Since 10:40 on September 1<sup>st</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village, which is located near “Gillad” settlement with a steel Gate.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b></li> <li>• At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, stormed 2-vehicle repair shops then withdrew at 22:50.</li> <li>• At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Kafr Thulth, stormed a home, detained two National Security Force officers then withdrew at 03:50.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> Israeli forces detained Khaled Jihad Baker Odah and Yusef Jihad Bakr Odah {both are National Security Force officers} during their raid into Kafr Thulth.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned at Jaljouliya wall gate in south Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured a child.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b></li> </ul>

Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ul>
