## SUMMARY OF EVENTS

Killing	3	-	3	2 residents were killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards them near "Kufr Itsiyon" settlement junction in Bethlehem for attempting to stab an Israeli soldier as alleged by the Israeli Military and another resident was killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards him along Al-Shuhada road in the old city of Hebron for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier (as alleged by the Israeli military).
Injury	49	-	49	7 in Ramallah, 2 in Tulkarem, 4 in Bethlehem and 36 in Hebron including 6 children and 4 women including 1 critically injured after being ran over by an Israeli settler vehicle and another resident after he was stabbed by an Israeli settler as he was working inside the Green Line.

<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On October 27<sup>th</sup> 2015, the Israeli army, continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound and prevented residents entering the mosque.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> <li>(iii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iv) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks.</li> <li>(v) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Sur Bahar with Cement blocks.</li> <li>(vi) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za'im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks.</li> <li>(vii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Wadi Al-Rabaybeh area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces considers Qalandiya checkpoint to be a border crossing point and only allows residents with Jerusalem Identification cards to enter the checkpoint.</li> <li>(ii) Since September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis and Shu'fat checkpoints and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to complete the construction of the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 09:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu searching residents and vehicles until 10:00.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At dawn on October 27<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and detained two children.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:30, Israeli forces positioned at a main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem detained Huda Abu Sneh.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

- **Detention:**
  - (i) At 04:00 on October 27<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Wael Al-Ajlouni during their raid into Hebron in addition to those mentioned in the previous report.
  - (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque compound in the old city of Hebron detained two residents including a child: Jihan Hatem Abdel-Azziz Erikat (17 years old) and Nour Hatem Abdel-Azziz Erikat (22 years old).
  - (iii) At 12:15, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron detained Jihad Zeid Al-Ja'bari and Salah Misbah Al-Ja'bari (Both are security guards at Al-Ibrahimi mosque compound).
  - (iv) At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Aroub camp detained Ibrahim Nayef Daraghme (A special needs patient) {A resident of Surif} for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier as allegedly by the Israeli military.
  - (v) On October 27<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained the child Malek Ayash Khalil Abu Mariya (11 years old) {A resident of Beit Ummar} while he was accompanied by his father as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon in "Kafir Itsiyon" settlement then they transferred him to a detention center in "Ofar" Prison / Military base.
  - (vi) Israeli forces detained three residents: Sakher Yusef Hamad Shartih (16 years old), Mo'ayad Abed Al-Birawi and Murad Mohammad Ibrahim Al-Jindi in Yatta.
  - (vii) Israeli forces detained four residents: Yazen Ali Hussien Tarayreh (17 years old), Hufaytha Suliman Tarayreh (17 years old), Mohammad Kifah Ali Manasra and Hazim Issa Tarayreh in Bani Na'im.
  - (viii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Adam Ahmad Abu Khiran (17- years old ) and Majed Taysir Al-Teeti ( 17- years old ) in Al-Aroub camp.
  - (ix) Israeli forces detained two residents: Obieda Daoud Al-Rajabi and Ayman Shaker Al-Jinidi in Hebron.
- **Attack:**
  - (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces positioned near Abu Al-Rish checkpoint located in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
