## **ALL DISTRICTS**

The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

### (i)

**Closure of Main Roads:** 

The Israeli army continues to close with barbed wire and cement blocks the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al-Bareed in the city of Jerusalem, after leveling the area, and to deny civilian access.

Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrances to al-Agsa Mosque compound in

The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt (ii) barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba'.

#### Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.

Raid: At 10:50, the Israeli army raided the village of Kafr Aqab, took photos for the houses located near the Wall and patrolled the area.

#### **Wall Gates:**

- The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu (i) Dis with cement blocks.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area of al-'Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from Beit Surik village to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of al-Jib village, in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna, and south of Beit Hanina village.

- Raid: At 00:25, the Israeli army raided Aqbat Jabir refugee camp in the city of Jericho and combed the camp's cemetery.
- Land Confiscation: On 10 October 2008, the Israeli army issued an order extending military order # 05/217/C confiscating 39.1 dunum of Jericho city land for military purposes (currently has the military site and the checkpoint at the southern entrance to Jericho city). This order is valid until 31 December 2011.

#### **Closure:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- Since September 15, 2007, the Israeli army has been preventing (ii) civilian access, according to military order 07.02.S, to the 22dunum land that has been confiscated in accordance with confiscation order number 07.31.T. The 22-dunum area has been set to construct a passage in the area of Mazmouriyyeh that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem.
- Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the two sideways east and south of Al Walaja village and the roads of Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmad, Talita-Nazlet As Sidr in the city of Beit Jala, Al Khadr town-Road # 60, Al Khadr town-Beit Jala housing, Wadi Rahal-Efrat and the sideway east of Beit Fajjar town.

#### **Flying Checkpoints:**

- (i) At 14:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near Ash Shawawrah village and searched civilians and vehicles.
- At 04:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on An Nashash (ii) area junction (the southern entrance to the city of Bethlehem) and searched civilians and vehicles until 06:00.
- Raid: At 19:45, the Israeli army raided the city of Bethlehem and Al Aza refugee camp in the city, opened indiscriminate fire for allegedly throwing a Molotov cocktail bomb towards a military observation tower set up in the periphery of Bilal Bin Rabah mosque (Al Qubba), set up a flying checkpoint in the city, patrolled the area and withdrew at 21:20.
- Palestinian Security Measure: At 13:55, the Palestinian side extradited to the Israeli side, through military liaison, 2 settlers mistakenly entered the city of Beit Jala.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of al-Khadr town; northwest of Beit Jala city; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of Ephrata settlement; and in the area surrounding al-Walaja village.

#### **BETHLEHEM**

#### • <u>Closure</u>:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.
- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from traveling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the area of al-Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to al-'Arrub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the villages of Al Karmil and At Tuwani and all roads leading to bypass Road # 60.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to open the iron gate on the junction of Farsh Al Hawa, which leads to Road # 35 that leads to Tarqumiya Crossing, from 05:00 until 07:00 and from 09:00 until 13:00.

#### • Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass leading to Halhul town and impeded civilian access.
- (ii) At 18:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Al Fahs area, south of Hebron city.

#### • Raids:

- (i) At 10:45, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Hebron. Again at 17:30, the Israeli army raided the area, set up a flying checkpoint and patrolled the city. Again at 00:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the area.
- (ii) At 00:35, the Israeli army raided Sa'ir town, searched a number of houses and was still in the area during the preparation of this report.

#### **HEBRON**

• <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of al-Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.
