<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 20:05, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint located along the main road, which connects Jerusalem Jericho and Ramallah and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:00. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Eizariya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 18:35, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as Israeli forces stormed a protest tent protesting the killing of Abdel Rahman Al-Shildawi and as a result left several resident suffocating from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the morning of October 28th 2014, Israeli forces detained four residents including two children: Ammar Abu Khdeir (16 years old), Anan Abu Khdier (17 years old), Mohammad Al-Joulani and Othman Abu Khdier in Shu’fat neighbourhood. (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces detained two residents including a woman: Hanan Anu Assab and Mohammad Za’al in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood. • <u>Assault on Education Sector:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces stormed “Silwan Boys School” in Silwan neighbourhood and attempted to detain several school children for alleged stoning. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 10:20, Israeli forces stormed Salah Al-Din road in the old city of Jerusalem and demolished a (4-floor) home owned by Sahar Al-Sharif for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 18:35, Israeli forces stormed Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem and forced three merchant stores to close down and

	<p>confiscated a horse.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli settlers, several Israeli Military Generals, the Israeli occupation Mayor of Jerusalem and the Minister of Israeli Religious affairs under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers. (ii) At 11:15, the Israeli minister of Antiquities and Archaeology under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 11:30 on October 27th 2014 closed the main road leading to “Bet El” settlement near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Ein Sina round about located along the main road connecting Ramallah and Nablus until 23:00. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atra Bridge until 22:50. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:00 on October 28th 2014, Israeli forces raided Rantis village then stormed and searched seven homes. (ii) At 16:20, Israeli forces raided Beituniya and clashed with several residents • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of “Ofar” military base fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result left the infant Khalil Atawi (2 years old) suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:10, Israeli forces raided Jaba’, clashed with its residents as they stormed several homes and as a result injured 4 residents : Amjad Jamarshah, Ashraf Abu Bakr, Mohammad Abdallah Amarneh and Mohamad Azam Amarneh then temporarily detained 2 residents: Jamil Abu Salah 916 years old) and Aref Abu Falah then released them at a later time and withdrew at 21:15. (ii) At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Jaba’, stormed and searched a vehchilcal spare parts and repair shop owned by Mohammad Khalayleh , detained three residents then withdrew at 04:20. (iii) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Qabatiya, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 06:40.

(ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Faysal Saba’neh, Tarik Abu Al-Rub and Usayed Zakarneh in Qabatiya. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 22:15, Israeli forces positioned at “Movo Dotan” settlement checkpoint temporarily detained Billal Sharqawi and Ahmad Turman then released them later.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 14:20, the Israeli Military continues to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 15:10. • <u>Detention:</u> On October 26th 2014, Israeli forces detained Fadi Dahaliya (A resident of Al-Shwikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem).

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun and temporarily detained Mohammad Khalaf for allegedly carrying a knife then released him after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers in “Qaddumin” settlement. • <u>Raid:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Habalah village until 10:45. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.

(ii) At 16:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road in Huwarah until 17:25. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces raided Assirah Al-Shimaliya, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes then withdrew at 20:00. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Zawiya village until 02:10. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Qarwat Bani Hassan village, detained four residents after storming their homes and temporarily detained Qusay Rayan and released him later then withdrew at 05:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained four residents: Majd Assi, Ahmad Rayan, Hatem Rayan and Layth Rayan in Qarwat Bani Hassan village.

(ii) At 06:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ein Dweik village located in North Jericho. • <u>Raid:</u> At 0040, Israeli forces raided Jericho and Aqaba, Jabr camps in Jericho city and, summoned Khalil Dawas to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 01:15.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road

(ii) At 10:35, Israeli forces raided Beit Jallah, stormed a restaurant, surveyed surveillance camera tapes then withdrew at 00:15 • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 1240, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Khadr fired stun and tear gas grenades several school children for alleged stoning. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detentions:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Adnana Sabieh and Ziyad Al-Zir in Jinata. (ii) Israeli force detained Yassin Badir (14 years old) in Al-Ayda camp.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiwn Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna locat6ed near the wall gate. (vii)At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Kahil until 14:00. (ii) At 17:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge. • <u>Attack:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Amir Abu Ayash in Beit Ummar. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 07:35, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron, temporarily detained the child Bara Jabr (13 years old) then released him at 07:55. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:25, Israeli settler stormed Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron and placed a barned wire fence around a plot of land owned by Mahmoud Qubani in an attempt to confiscate it. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces stormed Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron and prevented Jawad Abu Aisheh (A Palestinian Intelligence officer) from going to his home during which Israeli forces temporarily detained him and then released him later.

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Rafah.

<p>GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija’iya (Nahal ‘Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
