<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On October 28th 2015, the Israeli army, continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound and prevented residents entering the mosque. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks. (iv) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks. (v) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Sur Bahar with Cement blocks. (vi) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za’im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks. (vii) On October 14th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Wadi Al-Rabaybeh area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces considers Qalandiya checkpoint to be a border crossing point and only allows residents with Jerusalem Identification cards to enter the checkpoint. (ii) Since September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis and Shu’fat checkpoints and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to complete the construction of the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qalandiya village and searched residents and vehicles until 15:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on October 28th 2015 and again at 02:00, Israeli forces raided Hizma village, detained 4 children, clashed with several residents as the stormed a home and then detained another residents an withdrew at 05:30. (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village, clashed with several residents, detained a resident then withdrew at 22:00.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the morning of October 28th 2015, Israeli forces detained Jihad Al-Ghazawi after storming her home in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (ii) On the morning of October 28th 2015, Israeli forces detained Ghada Awadallah (A resident of Shu'fat neighbourhood) as she was reporting to the Israeli Police center in Al-Nabi Yacoub settlement based on a prior summon. (iii) At 20:10, Israeli forces detained four residents: Alaa Al-Khayat, Hisham Al-Qawasmi, Wissam Al-Qawasmi and Fadi Al-Zaghal in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood. (iv) Israeli forces detained 5 residents including 4 children: Mohammad Suliman Salah Al-Din (15 years old), Abdallah Jarrah Najib Salah Al-Din (15 years old), Salah Al-Din Shalabi (16 years old), Mohammad Jihad Askar (17 years old) and Eyad Khader Musa Sbieh in Hizma village. (v) Israeli forces detained Firas Tariq Al-Eisawi in Al-Eisawiya. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents and University students for alleged stoning as they were protesting the Israeli Military and settler assault against Al-Aqsa mosque compound and against civilians during which Israeli forces stormed Al-Quds University campus in Abu Dis as they chased after several University students and as a result injured 30 residents and left approximately 140 residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Ayyad area located between Dahiyat Al-Barid and Al-Aqbat are' in Al-Ram fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Medical Sector:</u> On October 28th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Al-Makkassed Hospital in Jerusalem and searched several rooms and sections of the hospital for allegedly searching for a patient inside the hospital. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 10:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli military forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near "Bet El" settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) At 11:25, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at entrance of Ni'lin. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village until 21:50. (ii) At 21:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance off Deir Al-Sudan village until 23:00. (iii) At 21:50, Israeli forces positioned near Ajoul village until 22:30. • <u>Raid:</u>

(iii) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Beit Rima, clashed with several residents, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:05. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mohammad Hassan Abu Saleem and Nadi Abdel Al-Thim Awwad in Rantis village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Thabet Al-Khatib in Beit Rima. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned Al-Mahkama checkpoint near “Bet El” settlement located in North Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they were protesting against the Israeli military and settlers assault against Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and violence against Palestinian citizens. (ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Zababda, stormed 2 homes and detained a resident. (ii) At 04:50, Israeli forces raided Jaba’, stormed several homes, detained a resident and summoned 2 residents: Amarat Islam and Murad Waleed Malaysheh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (iii) At 05:00, Israeli forces raided Arraba and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Taha Najeh Lutfi Al-Sharqawi in Al-Zababdeh. (ii) Israeli forces detained Murad Fashafsheh in Jaba’. (iii) Israeli forces detained Kamal Mazen Abu Taqa in Arrabah. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> At 02:30 on October 28th 2015, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Hisham Jameel Mahmoud Maslimani and Eyad Mustafa Mahmoud Maslamani during their raid into Tubas as mentioned in addition to those mentioned in the previous report.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Anabta fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 12:10, Israeli forces positioned near “Ghishouri” factory area located in West Tulkarem fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near “Ghishouri” factory area located in West Tulkarem temporarily detained Hamam Nasser Abdallah Haammam (A resident of Kafr Ra’i) then released him at a later time.
<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with a steel Gate. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Qaddumim” settlement then searched residents and vehicles. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Awarta with dirt mounds. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Beit Furiq checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic, detained two residents and temporarily detained Mohammad Abdel-Ra’ouf Sawalmah (A resident of Balata camp) then released him later. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Deir Sharaf village junction located along the main road connecting Nablus and Tulkarem, searched residents and vehicles until 10:35. • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Huwara, occupied the home of Qais Jihad Odeh and converted its rooftop into a military post. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces positioned at Beit Furiq checkpoint detained Mohammad Amer Hanini and Ahmad Ayman Malitat (Both residents of Beit Furiq).
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iii) At 09:20 on October 13th 2015, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks.

JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District and impeded the free flow of traffic until a later time. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at road (90) junction near Al-Nuwe'meh village located at the North entrance of Jericho then searched residents and vehicles until 22:00 and detained a resident. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road in Al-Oja village and searched residents and vehicles until 14:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint at road (90) junction near Al-Nuwe'meh village located at the North entrance of Jericho detained Mohammad Abu Zied (A resident of Ain Al-Sultan camp in Jericho).
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.

- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- (ix) At 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amoush" settlement with dirt mounds.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 07:00 on October 28th 2015, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar and searched residents and vehicles.
 - (ii) At 14:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ta'mar village and searched residents and vehicles until 16:00.
 - (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Taqou' and searched residents and vehicles until 17:40.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At dawn on October 28th 2015, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, detained a resident and summoned Ayman Ahmad Ishaq Hamoud to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
 - (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Husan village and detained 4 residents.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Amr Zabada in Bethlehem.
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Mohammad Khala Zaghoul, Mohammad Khader Abu Aher, Ahmad Ribhi Al-Harimi and Ahmad Rizq Al-Harimi in Husan village.
- **Temporary Detention:** At 16:05, Israeli forces positioned near the east entrance of Husan village temporarily detained Akram Subhi Abed Rabo Hamarat and Ahmad Mohammad Attiyah Hamirat then released them at 21:30 after making them pay a financial penalty of 1000 NIS.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 13:25, Israeli forces positioned near the West entrance of Beit Fajjar fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several resident for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents: Mohammad Ibrahim Thawabteh and Rami Mohammad Musa Hiyam then occupied a home owned by Mohammad Yacoub Taqatqa and converted its rooftop into a military post as well as leaving several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
 - (ii) At 14:55, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp located in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several resident for alleged stoning.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 and road # 35 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
 - (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Dura then searched residents and vehicles.
 - (ii) At 09:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fah's area located in south Hebron then searched residents and vehicles.
 - (iii) At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Halhoul Bridge then searched residents and vehicles.

- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Manara area located between Beit Fajjar and Al-Aroub camp then stormed and searched a home.
 - (ii) At 08:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Aroub camp, occupied 2 homes owned by Ibrahim Khamis Al-Ajouri and Atta Jawabra then converted their rooftops into Military posts and again at 02:00 stormed and searched several homes and detained a resident.
 - (iii) At 09:10, Israeli forces raided Farsh Al-Hawa area located in North Hebron.
 - (iv) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Yatta, stormed several homes, detained 2 residents including child then withdrew at 05:30.
