JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on October 30th 2014, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound and also closed access to Al-Aqsa mosque compound after the alleged shooting of the extremist Israeli settler Yahud Glick which left him seriously injured. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 20:00, Israeli military intensified their restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint, which connects Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho, impeded the free flow of traffic and detained a resident. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Bir Nabala Bridge. • <u>Assassination:</u> At 05:30, Israeli forces stormed Al-Thur neighbourhood in Jerusalem, surrounded a home and opened fire towards Mu’taz Hijazi and as a result killed him for the alleged shooting of the extremist Israeli settler Yahud Glick) and also injured 3 residents: Mahdi Burqan, Mohammad Hijazi and Mu’tasim Hijazi. • <u>Home Demolition:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces demolished a home owned by Khalid Al-Zir in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem and detained three residents including the owner of the home. (ii) On October 29th 2014, Israeli forces demolished a 200 m home owned by Musa Al-Tura and also demolished another home as well as the surrounding concrete wall owned by Thurba Khater and demolished 2 storage rooms and a car garage owned by Mohammad Abu Jibna and Khaled Abu Jibna in Al-Shiekh Jarah and Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhoods in Jerusalem. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces issued an order for the closure of a merchant shop in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in Jerusalem and detained two residents (owners of the shop). • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On October 26th 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Ahmad Sabha (15 years old) and Diya Masouda in Al-Thur and Silwan neighbourhoods in Jerusalem. (ii) On October 27th 2014, Israeli forces detained three residents: Amar Gahyath, Abed Sab Laban and Zaki Al-Sulti in Al-Tur and Wadi Al-juz neighbourhoods in Jerusalem. (iii) Israeli forces positioned at Jaba' checkpoint detained Yahya Khatib (a resident of Beeit Rima village in Ramallah). (iv) Israeli forces detained three residents: Murad Ghayth, Khalid Al-Zir and Fihmi Al-Zir in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (v) Israeli forces detained Nabil Taha and Ziyad Taha in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in Jerusalem. • <u>Attack:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned in Beit Hanina fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers. (ii) At 03:30, Israeli forces closed access to Al-Aqsa mosque compound and denied worshiper and tourists from entering the compound. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(iii) Since 11:30 on October 27th 2014 closed the main road leading to "Bet El" settlement near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Silwad until 10:30. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Ras Kar Kar village and detained a resident. (ii) At 02:00. Israeli forces raided Dur Al-Qatre' village and detained a resident

(iv) Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash'al village detained Issam Al-Bargjouthi (17 years old). • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces temporarily detained two resident: Mu'taz Al-Barghouthi and Mohammad Al-Barghouthi at the entrance of Deir Nathim village then released them at 23:15. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 02:10, Israeli settlers positioned near Ein Yabrud village stoned residents and vehicles then withdrew at 02:30.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Jenin camp, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:50. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Usayed Abu Ziena in Jenin camp.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun until 10:00. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqilya until 14:45. (iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:10 on October 29th 2014, Israeli forces detained Kafr Thulth and detained a resident. 	<p>officers for the alleged stoning of a settler vehicle then withdrew vat 15:20.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Alaa Thiyab in Kafr Thulth village. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 16:15, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Kafr Qaddum village, forcibly removed Saed Barham from his agricultural land as he was collecting Olive harvests and stole three sacks of Olives. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 17:15, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwarah checkpoint and impede the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:15, Israeli force sset up a checkpoint at the entrance of Awarta village (ii) At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq village until 19:00. (iii) At 00:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Yitsahar” settlement located in North Huwara and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:55, Israeli forces raided Aqraba until 14:55. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Osirin village. • <u>Detention:</u> At 01:30 on October 29th 2014, Israeli forces detained Sameh Jabr during their raid into Aqraba as mentioned in the previous report. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 15:45, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over and injured the child Ibrahim Odeh (13 years old) along the main road inn Huwara and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 15:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.

(ii) At 23:20 and again at 07:05, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho. • Temporary Detention: At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge temporarily detained Othman Odah (A Palestinian Police Officer) as he was returning from Jordan then released him later.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00 and again at 17:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Taqou'. 	<p>in east Beit Sahur until 23:00.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 15:10, Israeli forces raided Taqou', clashed with several residents as they occupied Adel Al-Amours home and converted its rooftop into a Military post then withdrew at 16:10. • <u>Attack:</u> At 15:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> at 13:30, Israeli forces positioned near "Kafir Etsiyon" settlement junction temporarily detained two residents: Maher Al-Qawasmeh and Bassamm Atwan then released them at 13:50. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On October 29th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Um Al-Rakaba area in Al-Khader and served a demolition order for a home owned by Khaled Salah and served a halt to construction order for a home owned by Mohammad Musa for allegedly being built without proper licensing because of their location in area C which is under Israeli military and administrative control.
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiw Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna located near the wall gate. (vii) At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge. (iii) At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Ummar bridge. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:30 on October 29th 2014, Israeli forces raided Khashim Daraj village located in east Yatta, demolished a barracks, a portion of a cave, an outdoor bathroom and a livestock shed owned by Mustafa Tabnat, Ahmad Tabnat and Ayed Al-Hathalini then detained a resident and assaulted Amneah Al-Hathalin (A pregnant woman) and as a result left her hospitalised with contusions.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) At 08:30, Israeli forces raided Um Al-Kheir village in east Yatta, demolished a storage room, assaulted several residents as they attempted to prevent the demolition and as a result injured six residents including a woman: Amenah Al-Hathalin, Mu'tasim Al-Hathalin, Musa Al-Hathalin, Tariq Al-Hathalin, Yasser Al-Hathlain, and Suliman Al-Hathalin. (iii) At 11:05, Israeli forces raided Hebron and set up a checkpoint near Hebron University campus. (iv) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Surif, stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 01:15. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Eid Al-Hathalin in Khashim Al-Daraj village located in east Yatta. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Fasfous in Surif.
