Killing	3	-	3	A resident died after Israeli forces prevented an Ambulance carrying him to a hospital after suffering a heart attack after stopping it near a checkpoint and road block in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem and 2 residents were killed after Israeli forces opened fire towards them for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier in Hebron.

<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On October 29<sup>th</sup> 2015, the Israeli army, continues to intensify their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound and prevented residents entering the mosque.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> <li>(iii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iv) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks.</li> <li>(v) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the North entrance of Sur Bahar with Cement blocks.</li> <li>(vi) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za’im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks.</li> <li>(vii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Wadi Al-Rabaybeh area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces considers Qalandiya checkpoint to be a border crossing point and only allows residents with Jerusalem Identification cards to enter the checkpoint.</li> <li>(ii) Since September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis and Shu’fat checkpoints and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to complete the construction of the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b></li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At dawn on October 29<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village, detained 7 residents including 2 children.</li> <li>(ii) At dawn on October 29<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and detained a resident.</li> <li>(iii) At dawn on October 29<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Jadirat village and detained a resident.</li> <li>(iv) At dawn on October 29<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya camp and detained a resident.</li> </ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At dawn on October 29<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Azziz Nassar and Jihad Bazlamit in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood.</li> <li>(ii) At dawn on October 29<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Zienah Amro (A resident of Silwan neighbourhood) after storming and searching her home.</li> <li>(iii) Israeli forces detained 7 residents: Mohammad Mahmoud Mahmoud (16 years old), Tamer Abu Al-Humus (13 years old), Firas Mahmoud, Mohammad Yusef Attiyeh, Mohammad Abdallah Mahmoud, Mahmoud Ali Mahmoud, and Mahmoud Gharayib in Al-Eisawiya village.</li> <li>(iv) Israeli forces detained Sameh Al-Qassas in Al-Eizariyeh village.</li> <li>(v) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Fawzi Azzam in Al-Jadirat village.</li> <li>(vi) Israeli forces detained Muntasir Sa'ed Matir in Qalandiya camp.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(ii) At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of “Koghav Yacoub” settlement fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Killing:</u></b> At 06:35 on October 29<sup>th</sup> 2015, Nadiem Shaqirat (52 years old) {A resident of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood} died after suffering a heart attack as Israeli forces prevented the ambulance carrying him from his house to the hospital to pass through the road blocks and past the traffic congestion caused by the Israeli military closure of the entrance of the neighbourhood in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem.</li> <li>• <b><u>Assault on Medical Sector:</u></b> On October 29<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces stormed Al-Makkassed Hospital in Jerusalem then fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents positioned in front of the hospital protesting against the continued Israeli act of aggression towards the hospital and calling for the International Organizations and Human rights Organization to carry out its responsibility to protect the Medical sector against Israeli Military aggression.</li> <li>• <b><u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u></b> At 09:30, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli military forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<p><b>TULKAREM</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> At 15:45 Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> At 07:45 on October 29<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained the child Usayed SZaleem Ibrahim Khoulou (17 years old) {A resident of Dahiyat Irtah in Tulkarem}.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> At 14:10, Israeli forces positioned near “Ghishouri” factory area located in West Tulkarem fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they were protesting against the Israeli military and settlers assault against Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and violence against Palestinian citizens and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</li> </ul>
<p><b>QALQILIYA</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.</li> <li>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</li> <li>(iii) Since 10:40 on September 1<sup>st</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with a steel Gate.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. <p><b>SALFIT</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</li> <li>(ii) Since 11:00 on July 30<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iii) At 09:20 on October 13<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> At 09:20, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 12:40.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ballout then searched residents and vehicles.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 19:10, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Dik.</li> </ul>
<p><b>JERICHO</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District and impeded the free flow of traffic until a later time.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 19:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho then searched residents and vehicles until 20:00</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 03:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village and stormed 2 homes.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 20:05, an Israeli settler positioned near "Banana Land" park located near Ein Dweik village located in North Jericho opened fire towards Akkaf Abu Al-Addas's vehicle as he passed near the area.</li> </ul>
<p><b>BETHLEHEM</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</li> <li>(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iii) Since August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.</li> <li>(iv) Since May 8<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.</li> <li>(v) Since June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalim and road 60 with dirt mounds.</li> <li>(vi) Since 13:20 on September 29<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.</li> <li>(vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

- (viii) On January 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- (ix) At 10:45 on September 8<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near “Malee Amoush” settlement with dirt mounds.
- **Raid:**
    - (i) At 13:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Khader, clashed with several residents and again at 21:50 raided the area and clashed with several residents (for the second consecutive time) then withdrew at 22:30.
    - (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Taqou’, stormed several homes then withdrew at 03:35.
  - **Temporary Detention:**
    - (i) At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned near “Ghush Itsiyon” settlement temporarily detained Hussien Mohammad Hassan Assad (A resident of Irtas village) then released them at a later time.
    - (ii) At 00:20, Israeli forces positioned near “Ghush Itsiyon” settlement temporarily detained Khader Jamil Janazrah (A resident of Al-Aroub camp) and summoned him to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 01:50.
  - **Attack:**
    - (i) At 15:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp located in North Bethlehem fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several resident for alleged stoning and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation during which Israeli forces occupied Nadeem Al-Sha’ers home and converted its rooftop into a military post and then temporarily detained Qassim Salah Abu Akker and released him at a later time.
    - (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned near the North entrance of Taqou’ fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several resident for alleged stoning.
    - (iii) At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Khadr fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several resident for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Mahmoud Ali Mohammad Issa (17 years old).
    - (iv) At 19:10, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Husan village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several resident for alleged stoning.
  - **Settler Violence:** At 13:15, Israeli settlers positioned in Wadi Al-Hums area located near Dar Salah village assaulted Khaled Mohammad Abu-Rajjab (A resident of Yatta) as he was collecting Olive harvests and as a result, left him hospitalised with a broken foot.

**HEBRON**

- **Closure:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
  - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
  - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 and road # 35 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
  - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
  - (v) Since July 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
  - (vi) At 11:00 on August 6<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
  - (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up 5 checkpoints near Al-Nabi Yunis (located along the main road connecting Hebron and Bethlehem), Wadi Qabbun area (located in North Hebron) junctions,, Beit Anoun village junction and at the north entrance of Hebron and Al-Fahs area located in south Hebron and along Halhoul bridge and searched residents and vehicles.
  - (ii) At 09:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Kahil then searched residents and vehicles.
  - (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhoul Bridge then searched residents and vehicles.
- **Raid:** At dawn on October 29<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Dura and detained a resident.
- **Detention:**
  - (i) At 04:10 on October 29<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained 2 children: Mahmoud Hani Abu Farat (16 years old) and Ismail Ghniemat (16 years old) during their raid into Surif village as mentioned in the previous report.
  - (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces detained 2 residents including a child: Khaled Mohammad Abu Mariya (17 years old) {A resident of Beit Ummar} and Kfah Al-Zour {A resident of Hebron}.
  - (iii) Israeli forces detained the child: Firas Mohammad Mahmoud Khalaf (17 years old) in Dura.
- **Attack:**
  - (i) At 08:35, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Aroub camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (ii) At 09:20, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Zahad area located in the old city of Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several resident for alleged stoning.
  - (iii) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several resident for alleged stoning and as a result injured 5 residents including a child: Zied Mustafa Al-Rajabi (17 years old), Thaer
