<p><b>JERUSALEM</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At dawn on October 30<sup>th</sup> 2014, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Sawahra Al-Sharqiya village detained a Security Force officer after storming his home and confiscating a Rifle.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:00, Israeli forces detained two residents: Hajib Al-Qadi and the brother of (Mu’taz Hijazi).</li> <li>(ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces detained Moath Darwish in the old city of Jerusalem.</li> <li>(iii) At 10:40, Israeli force positioned at Jaba’ checkpoint detained Ahmad Abu Khamsa ( A resident of Qalandiya camp)</li> <li>(iv) At 02:00, Israeli forces detained four residents: Jawad Siyam, Yazan Siyam, Mahmoud Ghayth and Muntasir Faraj in Wadi Al-Hilweh area in Silwan.</li> <li>(v) On October 30<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained Tawfiq Hirbawi after opening fire towards him and injuring him after he allegedly attempted to run over an Israeli soldier in Wadi Al-Joz neighbourhood.</li> <li>(vi) On October 30<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained Nidal Abu Gharbiya (A Red Cross hospital Paramedic) in the old city of Jerusalem.</li> <li>(vii) Israeli forces detained Omar Abu Hussein (A National Security force officer) in Al-Sawahra Al-Sharqiya.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Temporary Detention:</u></b> At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Thuri neighbourhood temporarily detained Ibrahim Hijazi then released him after serving him a demolition order to demolish his home.</li> </ul>
