The ceasefire has been further renewed on 23 June 2012 at 24:00.</li> <li>On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark.</li> <li>Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza and Khan Yunis.</li> <li>Israeli aircrafts broke the cease fire agreement by launching 2 missiles towards Gaza leaving 2 residents Injured.</li> <li>Palestinian gunmen broke the ceasefire agreement by launching projectiles towards the Green Line.</li> </ul>
