JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Jaba’ village. • <u>Raid:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate next to Al-Quds University in Abu Dis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Mohammad Sinuqrut (15 years old) leaving him hospitalised in critical condition {Serious Head Injury} and injured another child as they detained him. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli force detained Diya’ Al-Sharaabati (17 years old) in Wadi Al-

	<p>Juz neighbourhood in Jerusalem.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 19:20, a group of Israeli settlers assaulted Ahlam Abdel-Salam Awad in Shu'fat neighbourhood and left her hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ein Ayoub area in Deir Amar village until 21:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 13:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Liqya, clashed with several residents, ordered the removal of a car wash lot owned by Issa Khamis Assi and served a demolition order for a vegetable selling shop owned by Salah Mohammad Bader for allegedly being built without a licence because of its location in area C (which is under Israeli Military and Administrative control) then withdrew at 14:30. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 17:25, Israeli forces positioned near "Hashmoni'im" settlement located in south Al-Madiya village temporarily detained the child :Jabr Jallal Sadaqa (15 years old) {A resident of Al-Maya' village} during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children then released him at 20:30.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:35, Israeli forces raided Jenin until 13:30. (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad until 19:40.
<p>TUBAS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Far'a camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed eight homes, detained two residents including a child then withdrew at 06:25. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Salah Hussein Sawalma (15 years old) and Attiya Ismail Mahdawi.
<p>TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near "Aveni Hivits".

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 19:30, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 24:00. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Shufa and Izbit Shufa village and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) At 07:00 on September 1st 2014, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Bazariya village in east Anabta. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Fara’oun village until 01:30.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 07:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun, temporarily detained two residents: Mahmoud Sa’ed Radwan (A national Security force officer) and Shaddad Hisham Adwan then released them later. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 11:15. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Yitsahar” settlement junction located in north Huwara and closed the bypass road located near the settlement thus impeded the free flow of traffic until 10:00. (ii) At 20:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Salem and Deir Al-Hatab, fired flash grenades, and temporarily detained two residents including a Police officer: Jibril Zamil (a Police officer) and Yusef Al-Araq then withdrew at 21:00. (iii) At 20:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Dajan village; temporarily detained Shadi Abdel-Rahman Abu Jish then released him later and withdrew at 21:00. (iv) At 20:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 21:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:35, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Hatab village and stormed a home.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Settler Violence: At 11:00, Israeli settlers stormed Khirbeit Yanun village located in east Aqraba, attacked, and searched a home owned by Khadr Musalim Haniya then withdrew at 11:50.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks. (v) At 24:00 on August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: At 20:45, Israeli forces raided Masha village, stormed and searched several merchant shops then withdrew at 22:00.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: At 23:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Jiftlik village junction until 01:00.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.

	<p>(vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Taqou' until 15:00. (iii) At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Nihalin village until 21:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on August 31st 2014, Israeli forces raided Husan village, stormed a home and detained a child. (ii) At 04:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and as a result injured 4 residents: Yunis Mohammad Zaghari, Saber Faysal Ma'ali, Basil Waleed Da'asmeh and Mohammad Musa Zaghari and detained a residents then withdrew at 05:20 detained a Police officer until 06:20. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00 on August 31st 2014, Israeli forces detained Tamer Sabah Abu Daya after storming his home and summoned Ali Ahmad Awayda to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning as mentioned in the previous report. (ii) Israeli forces detained Ahamd Issam Ibrahim Hamarah (17 years old) in Husan village. (iii) Israeli forces detained Zaher Fawaz Abdel-Fatah Zahran in Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem. • <u>Land Confiscation:</u> On August 31st 2014, The Israeli Military issued an order for the confiscation of 3811 dunumes in Surif, Wadi Fuqin and Al-Jab'a village in Bethlehem and Hebron districts for expanding "Ghush Itsiyon" settlement and gave the landowners a period of 40 days to oppose the Military order in Israeli courts.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.

(ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Jihad Ahmad Abu Ayash and Muntasir Yusef Abu Ayash in Beit Ummar. • <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of August 31st 2014, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Thaher area located in Beit Ummar near “Karmi Tsur” settelemnt fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 18:15, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Ithna assaulted two children: Badr Jihad Abdel-Fattah Abu Zaltah (16 years old) and Kathim Abdel-Hamid Salamah Al-Najjar (17 years old). • <u>Land Confiscation:</u> On August 31st 2014, The Israeli Military issued an order for the confiscation of 12 dunumes of land in Sa’ir for expanding “Isfar” settlement and gave the landowners a period of 7 days to oppose the Military order in Israeli courts.

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.

(iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance.
