JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 16:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram and clashed with several residents.</li> <li>(ii) At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Biddu until 02:20.</li> <li>(iii) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and Abu Dis.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Settlement Activity:</u></b> At dawn on September 1<sup>st</sup> 2015, a group of Israeli settlers from “Aterot Kohana” Organization under the protection of Israeli forces forcibly took over a home owned by Jihad Sarhan (Deceased) in Batn Al-Hawa area in Silwan neighbourhood after Israeli forces broke into the main entrance during which local residents clashed with Israeli forces as they attempted to prevent the settlers from taking over the home during which Israeli forces detained 3 residents including a woman.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On August 31<sup>st</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Ramzi Al-Rajabi (A resident of Shu’fat camp).</li> <li>(ii) On August 31<sup>st</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Thaer Abu Sneineh near Bab Al-Majlis gate (A main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem.</li> <li>(iii) At 02:15, Israeli forces detained the child Yusef Al-Hazina (15 years old) in the old city of Jerusalem.</li> <li>(iv) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Samah Sarhan, Maher Sarhan and Ammar Abed in Batn Al-Hawa area in Silwan neighbourhood.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Home Demolition:</u></b> On the morning of August 31<sup>st</sup> 2015, Israeli forces positioned near Jaba’ village demolished 15 barracks (residential and livestock) owned by Al-Ar’ara family for allegedly being built without a licence because of its location in area C which is under Israeli Military and Administrative control.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b></li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>RAMALLAH &amp; AL BIREH</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages.</li> <li>(ii) At 21:40 on June 30<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near “Bet El” settlement leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iii) At 13:25 on August 7<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed a bypass road leading to Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoint:</b> At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Taybeh junction located along the main road connecting Ramallah and Jericho.</li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 02:10 on August 31<sup>st</sup> 2015 and again at 02:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, detained a child and then detained another child after assaulting him during which they clashed with several residents until 02:50.</li> <li>(ii) At 15:10, Israeli forces raided Deir Bibwan village until 15:20.</li> <li>(iii) At 15:40, Israeli forces raided Awura, clashed with several residents and as a result injured Mohammad Abu Al-Hajj then withdrew at 17:20.</li> <li>(iv) At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Beitin village and clashed with several residents.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Detention:</b> Israeli forces detained Abdel-Fattah Al-Arouri (16 years old) and Ma’moun Mujahid (16 years old) in Al-Bireh city.</li> <li>• <b>Settler Violence:</b> At 01:00 on August 31<sup>st</sup> 2015, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Al-Mazra’a Al-Qibliya village and set fire to a bulldozer owned by Ahmad Idris and spray painted racist slogans.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>JENIN</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Road:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan.</li> <li>(ii) Since the evening of November 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Jenin and its camps, clashed with several residents as they surrounded then stormed and searched several homes in the city and its camps and occupied the rooftop of Mohammad Al-Tubassi’s home and converted it into a Military post during which they exchanged gun fire with several Palestinian gunmen and fired <b>Energa</b> anti-tank rifle <b>grenade</b> towards a home owned by Majdi Abu Hijyeh in the camp and as a result was demolished and also demolished a merchant shop owned by Ramzi Abu Ghurieb and as a result injured 5 residents: including a child: Islam Dabaya (15 years old) who was ran over by an Israeli Military Jeep and detained a resident as well as temporarily detaining Suhayeb Majdi Abu Al-Hijyeh and Alaa Raja Abu Al-Hijyeh and released them at a later time then withdrew at 06:00.</li> <li>• <b>Detention:</b> Israeli forces detained Majid Abu Al-Hijyeh in Jenin Camp.</li> <li>• <b>Settler Violence:</b> At 09:20, Israeli settlers stormed “Homeish” settlement area {which was abandoned} then withdrew at a later time.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.</li> </ul>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>QALQILIYA</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.</li> <li>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</li> <li>(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 11:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Funduq village.</li> <li>(ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum village, stormed 4 homes, detained 4 residents and summoned Mohammad Ishtewi to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:40.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> Israeli forces detained Bashar Ishtewi in Kafr Qaddum village.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<b>HEBRON</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</li> <li>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.</li> <li>(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.</li> <li>(v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.</li> <li>(vi) At 11:00 on August 6<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Hajjra village located in south Dura with dirt mounds.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 17:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Amra village.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
