<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned in near Shu’fat checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> *It was clarified that on the morning of August 31st 2015, Israeli forces positioned near Jaba’ village demolished 10 homes for Al-Arrara family and 6 livestock barracks (11 homes and 7 Livestock barracks) owned by Talib Arrara, Ahmad Saray’a, Salem Arrara, Saleh Arrara, Fihmi Arrara, Ibrahim Arrara,, Raed Arrara, , Najah Arrara ,Ali Malihat, Khalil Malihat and Abdel Salam Malihat for allegedly being built without licence because of its location in area C which is under Israeli Military and Administrative control and located near (Guavi Banyamin Adam) settlement located near east Jaba’ village. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces and Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) At 21:40 on June 30th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near “Bet El” settlement leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) At 13:25 on August 7th 2015, Israeli forces closed a bypass road leading to Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh and temporarily detained Bassam Al-Tamimi and his wife then released them at a later time.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, stormed and searched a home and a Supermarket then withdrew at 12:20. (ii) At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Silwad, detained 2 residents including a child then withdrew at 03:45. (iii) At 03:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Jalazoun camp, detained 4 residents including 2 children then withdrew at 04:30. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Musa Hamad (17 years old), Qayed Hamad and Ziyad Hamad in Silwad. (ii) Israeli forces detained four residents: Usayed Nakhlah (17 years old), Adel Hasuna (15 years old), Mohammad Al-Bayad and Mohammad Al-Biri in Al-Jalazoun camp. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:40, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of “Pesagout” settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. (ii) At 19:45, Israeli forces positioned near Attarah bridge located in North Bir Ziet fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near The Arab American University in Jenin. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:45, Israeli forces raided Bir Al-Basha village until 16:15. (ii) At 03:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Silah Al-Harhiya and Kafr Dan villages, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 04:50. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Mohammad Abbad and Iz Al-Din Zayoud in Al-Silah Al-Harhiya and Kafr Dan villages. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Shwikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem, detained a resident then withdrew at 06:00. (ii) At 05:50, Israeli forces raided Attil until 07:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Salam Al-Bidawi in Al-Shwikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces demolished and removed several merchant carts located near Al-Tabeh checkpoint located in South west Tulkarem.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.

	<p>(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces detained the child Waleed Saleem (15 years old) on east Jayyus. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Burin village junction until 14:30. (ii) At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Tel village until 17:45. (iii) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Aqraba until 17:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:30, Israeli forces raided Aqraba, temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning with Israeli Intelligence officers. (ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Nablus and summoned Hassan Al-Shafe'i to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:00.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Detention:</u> At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint junction detained Akram Abu Hamidan (A National Security Force officer) {A resident of Beituniya in Ramallah} for allegedly carrying a pistol.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:00 and again at 21:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the South entrance of Jericho and detained a resident. (ii) At 19:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Jericho. (iii) At 00:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 01:30. • Raid: At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Jericho and Ein Al-Sultan camp, stormed several homes, and summoned 3 residents: Majdi Owidat, Hassan Al-Najjar and Musa Za'tara to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:50. • Detention: Israeli forces positioned near the south entrance of Jericho detained Mohammad Dawabsheh (A resident of Duma village in Nablus).
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahur. (ii) At 19:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Taqou', clashed with several residents the withdrew at 21:00. (iii) At 24:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Husan village, temporarily detained Wajdi Husniyeh (A National Security Force officer) and released him later then withdrew at 01:00. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Doha until 10:15.

	(ii) At 12:10, Israeli forces raided Khirbiet Al-Dier village located near Taqou' and occupied Nayef Musa'a Home and converted its rooftop into a military post then withdrew at 13:50.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Hajjra village located in south Dura with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge until 12:00. (ii) At 11:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Thahriya until 13:40. (iii) At 18:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Bithan, temporarily detained 2 residents: Sami Al-Hatawi and Fadi Awadeh then released them at 19:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:55, Israeli forces raided until 00:30. (ii) At 00:15, Israeli forces raided Yatta until 00:50. (iii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed a University students Dormitory then withdrew at 02:00. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Nael Al-Qadi then released him at 14:25. (ii) At 21:20, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained the child Issam Abu Ammr (13 years old) then released him at 23:50. (iii) At 07:55, Israeli forces positioned near Turma village temporarily detained the child Mohammad Hajja (10 years old) {a resident of Deir Razeh} then released him later.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'ya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Raid: At 08:00, Israeli forces escorting several military bulldozers stormed 200 m into the vicinity of east Al-Shuja'ya neighbourhood located in east Gaza and opened fire as they levelled a plot of agricultural land then withdrew at 13:00.
KHAN YUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Detention: At 20:00, Israeli forces detained an unidentified residents attempting to climb the broader fence into Israel from east Khan Yunis.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
