WEST BANK

(i) Closure:

- a. The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- b. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- c. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

(ii) Closure of Main Roads:

- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

- (vi) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (vii)On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

- (ix) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Khan Al-Hamra area located along the main road connecting Jerusalem and Jericho and detained two residents for allegedly carrying weapons.
- (x) At 23:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Anata.
- (xi) At 00:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu until 04:40.

At 17:00 to 18:30, Israeli Forces raided the village of El Issawieh, confrontations took place, a house of the resident Ibraheem Mustafa was set to fire as a result.

- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement, the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 00:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Tagou' until 01:15.

• Raid:

- (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Khirbeit Al-Dier located near Taqou' and served military orders for the demolition of 12 homes owned by: Musa Ayash, Shaher Suliman, Yasser Musa, Nasser Al-Boum, Munthir Ayash, Salim Musa, Ali Suliman, Ass'ad Suliman, Yusef Suliman, Munir Suliman, Mohammad Salameh, Ahmad Salameh for allegedly being built without a licence because of their location in Area C which is under full Israeli Military and administrative control then withdrew at 13:00.
- (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem, clashed with several residents and as a result injured a child as they detained him then withdrew at 00:25.
- (iii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Sahur until 04:30.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Anan Malash (15 years old) in Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem.
- Attack: At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

BETHLEHEM

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Hajjra village located in south Dura with dirt mounds.

• Raid:

- (i) At dawn on September 2nd 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Orub camp, detained 3 residents after assaulting them and summoned Oday Husiyah to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
- (ii) At dawn on September 2nd 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar and detained a resident.
- (iii) At 08:40, Israeli forces raided Dura, stormed a home and summoned Yunis Al-Huroub to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
- (iv) At 08:50, Israeli forces raided Beit Ula then stormed and searched a home.
- (v) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya until 17:55.

• Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Mahmoud Addrabah, Yusef Shartat (after assaulting him) and Mu'tasim Jawabra in Al-Orub camp.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Bashir Abu Ayash in Beit Ummar.
- <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 10:50, Israeli forces stormed Sha'b Al-Batun area located in South east Yatta and served a military order for the demolition of a local school.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 08:25, an Israeli settler vehicle travelling in east Yatta ran over and killed 5 heads of sheep owned by Issa Abu Aram.
- (ii) At 09:15, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near "Hagi" settlement located in south Hebron temporarily abducted several Security Guards for "Pal Safe" Security Company during which Israeli forces released them later.
