JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Since August 21st 2011 the Israeli army restricted access at checkpoints located at the entrances to Jerusalem City and to prevent civilians from other Palestinian districts from entering the city, except those holding special permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. • Attack on Worship Places: On the morning of 04. 09. 2011, Israeli settlers protected by Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque courtyard. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma’ale Adumim
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • Flying checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at the entrance to Silwad, searching vehicles and people. • At 23:05, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at the crossroads of Deir Sudan village, searching vehicles and people. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 10:30 am, Israeli forces raided Ramallah, and set up a checkpoint • At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Rima, and arrested a citizen.

	<p>Arrests: Detained in the town of Beit Rima is: Mahmoud Ezzat..</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Flying checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 08:00, Israeli forces set up checkpoint at Zarya village, east of Anabta, searching vehicles and people. • At 10:30, Israeli forces set up checkpoint on the road Kafriyat (road between Tulkarm and Qalqilya), searching vehicles and people. • At 10:30, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint between the villages of Kafr Sur and Kafr El-Gamal. • Checkpoints: Israeli army stepped up restrictions on Palestinian access at ‘Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus road, impeding the free flow of traffic • Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of ‘Azzun. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras ‘Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Flying checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - At 09:10, Israeli forces set up checkpoint at the entrance to Immatin village, vehicles and people.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - At 10:15, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at the entrance to Kafr village. - At 16:00, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint between Azzun Ezbet Al Tabib. • <u>Raids:</u> At 11:50, Israeli forces raided Jet village, and delivered military orders to stop building in 3 houses, owned by Nidal Khalid, Abdul Salamm and Jamal Hussein. • <u>Temporary Detentions</u> :At 20:00, Israeli forces detained four brothers near Karni Shomro settlement and released later, and they were: Ibrahim Ahmad Radwan and his brothers and Salah Saleh and Islam. • <u>Settlers Attack:</u> - On 30. 08. 2011, a group of settlers from Kedumim settlement stormed an agricultural lands owned by people from Kafr, and cut 15 trees olives. The land owned by Ahmed Dawood. - At 07:30, Israeli settlers threw stone towards cars near Jett village, resulting in a smashed car, owned by Mohammed Said Salah. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osarin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osarin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: (ii) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and 02:00 only to residents of the neighbourhood. (iii) At 'Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. <u>Flying checkpoints:</u> At 10:05, Israeli settlers setup a checkpoint between Nablus and Assira village, repeated at 18:00, searching cars and people. At 13:20, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at the crossroads village of Salem, searching vehicles and people. At 07:10, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint on the junction of Yitzhar settlement, and prevented people from passing on the bypass road leading to the Village Jett. <u>Raids:</u> At 23:55 am, Israeli forces raided Assira and arrested 2 of brothers. At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Badan village. At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Beit Furik, Kabalan, Beit Efrén, Jaffa and Tal village. At 02:40, Israeli forces raided a public housing area located east of Nablus, and

	<p>arrested a citizen.</p> <p><u>Arrests:</u> Arrested in Assira are: Adham and Mohammed Sholley. Detained in the area of public housing located east of Nablus city is: Shadi Ashkar.</p> <p><u>Settler Attacks:</u> At 07:20, Israeli settlers raided Kussra village, and set on fire on the ground floor of a mosque, resulting in damage to the contents of the mosque, which covers an area about 200 m2, and wrote graffiti in Hebrew on the walls of anti-Arab slogans.</p>
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds and cement blocks the northern entrance to Bruqin town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (iii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to increase restrictions on Zatara checkpoint, obstructing the free flow of traffic and detained 2 civilians. • <u>Flying checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - At 23:40, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at the entrance to Yasuf village, searching vehicles and people. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Bani Hassan, and delivered notifications to two brothers for an appointment with Israeli intelligence: Adnan Ahmed and Ali Marei. - At 01:30, Israeli forces handed Ibrahim Abdul Qader Yousef, a notice for an appointment with the Israeli intelligence. - At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Bediya village. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction has resumed in the area north of Deir Istia town southeast of the illegal settlement Emmanuel.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al 'Auja village with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area. And from 23:20 to 23:50, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint while searching the surrounding area. (ii) Israeli forces continue to restrict access at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-'Auja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) At 19:00, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho, searching vehicles and people. • <u>Raids:</u> At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Jericho and Ein Sultan refugee camp and searched several houses and arrested 3 citizens (one in the Ein el-Sultan and 2 brothers in Aqbat Jaber camp obstacle algebra), and pulled out at 04:40. • <u>Arrests:</u> The 3 detainees in the camps of Ein al-Sultan and Aqbet Jaber are: Anas Shawa,

	Ayouti and Amar Hamza.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israeli army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. • Checkpoints: At 09:10, Israeli forces increased restrictions on civilian movement at the "Container" checkpoint, temporarily detained 7 civilians and impeded the free flow of traffic until 10:20. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - At 08:45, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint on the junction Alnshash (the southern entrance to Bethlehem), searching vehicles and people. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - At 10:35, Israeli forces raided Abaydia village, and searched two houses. - At 21:30, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and Beit Jala. - At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Al Shawawrah village, and searched several houses and arrested three people. • Arrest: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Detainees in the village of Al Shawawrah village were: Mohammed Ibrahim, Muhammad Adnan Hamdan, Salim Adel Odai. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed northwest of Beit Jala town.
Hebron	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzaq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. (iii) On 26. 08. 2011, Israeli forces tightened their restrictions at the checkpoints, and metal gates at the entrances of the old city of Hebron, and setup checkpoints for inspections, hindering the access of citizens to perform the last Friday prayers of the month of Ramadan in the Ibrahim Mosque. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmel villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.

	<p>(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - At 20:00, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at the entrance to Beit Kahil village, searching vehicles and people. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - At 11:50, Israeli forces raided Hebron city, until 19:20. - At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Gawen Fawqa village, south of Samu, and arrested three people (including two brothers). - At 00:40, Israeli forces raided village, and searched several houses. - At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Nuba village. • <u>Arrests:</u> Detainees in Gawen Fawqa were: Ali Mohammed Hussein Dgamin, Sulaiman Abdul Rahman and his brother Younis Dgamin. • <u>Injured:</u> At 19:30, Israeli forces injured three Palestinians near Susia village, east of Yatta. They were Mahmoud Hany Alhreinna - a broken pelvis, and wounded 3 citizens who were with him - injuries and bruises are: Ahmed Hmamdh, Raed Saleh Dgamin and Mohammed Dgamin, in addition to causing physical damage to his car, which was led as a result of car crash by a military jeep during the pursuit. They were all taken to the hospital for treatment. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Dhahiriya town.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On 18. 01. 2009 at 02:00, a ceasefire was announced by the Israel, and agreed by Palestinian armed groups, and it was renewed-21:00 h on 21. 08. 2011. • Israeli forces violated a ceasefire when they raided areas in north Gaza and fired towards Gaza from the green line.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is closed. • Raids: At 24:00, Israeli forces raided areas north of Beit Hanoun, and clashed with members of the armed Palestinian groups.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Al-Muntar (Karnei) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. - Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
Khan Younis	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fire Arms: On 04. 09. 2011, Israeli forces opened fire from their positions on the Green Line, the direction of agricultural land and houses east of the town of Khuza'a.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Yasser Arafat International Airport: closed. - Sufa crossing: closed. - Karm Abu Salem/Kerem Shalom crossing: closed. - portal-Awdah/Rafah crossing: open for entry and travel of students, patients, and those with residence and visas.
