<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Detention:</u> At 16:35, Israeli forces detained two residents including a child: Awni Sa’ed (17 years old) and Mohammad Abu Assab after storming their home in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood in Jerusalem. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces assaulted and injured a guard at Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem. (ii) At 18:15, Israeli forces assaulted and injured two residents: Mu’taz Al-Abidiya and Eyad Al-Abidiya (both residents of Bethlehem) as they were in Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atarah Bridge and detained a resident. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on September 4th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Madiya village

	<p>and detained a resident.</p> <p>(ii) At 15:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 16:55.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <p>(i) Israeli force detained Eyad Awawdeh (A resident of Al-Bireh) near Atarah Bridge.</p> <p>(ii) Israeli forces detained Rizq Sayf Salameh in Al-Madiya village.</p> • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 20:30, Israeli settlers stoned residents and vehicles along the main road near “Bet El” settlement located in north Al-Bireh city and as a result injured Manal Lutfi Taher leaving her hospitalised with contusions.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan.</p> <p>(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad.</p> • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village until 19:30.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Al-Far’a and Al-Bithan villages until 14:00.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road.</p> <p>(iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”.</p> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 09:10, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem until 13:00. • <u>Attack:</u> At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Zieta fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <p>(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.</p> <p>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</p> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<p>village of Osrin.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Nassiriya village, stormed 11 homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 13:35. (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Bithan village until 13:20. (iii) At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Subustiya and Burqa villages until 01:20. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Issa Kassab in Al-Nassiriya village.
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 15:25, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> On September 4th 2014, Israeli authorities published the tenders for the construction of 283 settlement units in "Al-Kana" settlement located on land occupied in 1967 in Salfit.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00 and again at 22:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-Nuw'emeh village in North Jericho until 22:45 (ii) At 23:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 00:10. (iii) At 24:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint Al-Nabi Musa area located along the road, which connects Jericho and Jerusalem until 01:50.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the southeastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara

	<p>and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.</p> <p>(iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.</p> <p>(iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.</p> <p>(v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Taqou' until 19:55. (ii) At 21:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Taqou' until 00:30. • <u>Detention:</u> On the evening of September 3rd 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Container checkpoint detained Mohammad Assakrah (A resident of Assakra village).
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiwn Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and AlRas area in Ithna locat6ed near the wall gate. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction until 08:30. (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Beit Enuin village junction, temporarily detained two residents including a Security Force

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.

RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents , students , tourists and businessmen Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
