<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 01:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Anata. • <u>Attack:</u> At 19:40, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned at Jaba’ checkpoint detained Murad Satafi (A resident of Al-Ram) for allegedly carrying an M-16 assault rifle. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) At 21:40 on June 30th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near “Bet El” settlement leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) At 13:25 on August 7th 2015, Israeli forces closed a bypass road leading to Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah bridge located at the North entrance of Bir Ziet until 22:55.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) At 21:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Deir Dibwan Bridge until 22:50. (iii) At 22:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Beit Ur Al-Foda and Beit Ur Al-Tahta villages until 22:55. • Raid: At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Rima and summoned Ahmad Yassin to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 04:20.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • Raid: At 17:30, Israeli forces raided Zubaba village and stormed the home of the head of the local village council. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assault on Property: At 09:00, Israeli forces served several residents military orders to evacuate their homes in Bardala village located in the North Jordan valley in Tubas from September 9th 2015 until September 11th 2015 for alleged military exercises.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: At 21:45, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:20.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • Raid: At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Hajja village. • Demonstration: At 16:30, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum village protesting against the Israeli military continued closure of the villages east entrance during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators in order to prevent them from reaching the demonstration site (the closed entrance) and as a result left several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalation and also damaged a vehicle owned by Abdel-Latif Al-Qaddumi. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement

<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<p>of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beita until 17:35. (ii) At 21:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Awarta and Walada villages until 23:25. (iii) At 21:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Yitsahar” settlement located in North Huwara until 23:10. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq, clashed with several residents and occupied the home of Rida Nassasra and converted its rooftop into a military post then withdrew at 23:25. (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Qussin village.
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 12:40 and again at 18:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 19:30.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash junction located at the south entrance of Bethlehem until 13:45. (ii) At 17:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Jab'a village until 18:40. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem, detained a resident after storming his home then withdrew at 05:30. (ii) At 05:00, Israeli forces raided Nihalin village detained a resident and summoned three residents to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:10. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Mohmoud Al-Badawna in Al-Ayda camp. (ii) Israeli forces detained Abdel-Hadi Shakarna in Nihalin village.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.

HEBRON	<p>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Hajjra village located in south Dura with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Thahriya. (ii) At 13:00, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at Suisa village junction. (iii) At 16:40, Israeli forces set up two checkpoints at the entrances of Tarqumiya and Ithna. (iv) At 16:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Shiyoukh Al-Arab village. (v) At 20:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sa'ir. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces raided Yatta, detained a resident and confiscated his vehicle. (ii) At dawn on September 6th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched a home, detained a resident, set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of town then temporarily detained several labours and released them later. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Al-Shawahin in Yatta. (ii) Israeli forces detained Ziyad Al-Odah in Beit Ummar. • <u>Physical Assault:</u> At 01:10, Israeli forces positioned near "Shim'at" settlement located in south Al-Thariya assaulted three residents: Mohammad Al-Shamsali (fractured leg), Thaer Abu Qubtiya and Fayez Harb. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On September 5th 2015, a group of Israeli settlers positioned along Al-Shuhada' road in the old city of Hebron assaulted and sprayed pepper spray onto the faces of 2 residents inducing a child: Abdel-Rahim Al-Bayad (17 years old) and Ayman Al-Fakhouri and as a result left them hospitalised with contusions.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and Central Gaza. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed. • Attack: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the morning of September 5th 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several farmers located in Bu'rat Abu Samara area in North Beit Lahiya. (ii) On the morning of September 6th 2015, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach located in west Beit Lahiya.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p style="text-align: center;">CENTRAL GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in east Al-Maghazi camp.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
