<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 00:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu. • <u>Raid:</u> At dawn on September 7th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village, stormed several homes and detained two residents. • <u>Attack:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Isawiya village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Aliyan and Mahmoud Mustafa in Al-Eisawiya village. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) At 21:40 on June 30th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near “Bet El” settlement leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) At 13:25 on August 7th 2015, Israeli forces closed a bypass road leading to Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah bridge located at the North entrance of Bir Ziet until 15:30. (ii) At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Taybeh junction located along the main road connecting Ramallah and Jericho. (iii) At 20:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ur village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:20 and again at 04:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, stormed and searched several homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:20. (ii) At 12:35, Israeli forces raided Kharbathat Bani Harith until 13:10. (iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, stormed and searched a home, detained a journalist then withdrew at 04:00. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Najwan Ayman Odeh in Al-Bireh city. (ii) Israeli forces detained Fadi Manasra in Beituniya. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Ain Al-Ma’ area located in the area between Al-Nabi Saleh and Deir Nathim villages then withdrew at 13:45. (ii) At 23:30, a group of Israeli settlers stormed the entrance of Al-Janiya village then withdrew at 01:00.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the evening of September 6th 2015, Israeli forces raided Turat village, stormed a merchant shop, and temporarily detained the child: Hassan Qubha (14 years old) for alleged stoning then released him at a later time. (ii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Jenin and its camps, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 06:10. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Tubas, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 03:40.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 20:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 03:40.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Qaddum village until 11:45. (ii) At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. • Raid: At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum village until 03:00. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Yatma village junction. (ii) At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 22:00. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Sarah village until 13:00. (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Sharaf village. (iii) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Nablus, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched a home, detained a University student, confiscated a computer and 2500 NIS and during which the mother of the detained student was hospitalised after suffering from a nervous breakdown and Israeli forces damaged the main entrance door of a restaurant after storming it and as a result damaged a vehicle owned by Mahmoud Abu Khader then withdrew at 03:50. (iv) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Salem and Deir Al-Hatab villages, stormed and searched a home in Deir Al-Hatab village then withdrew at 05:30. (v) At 05:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Dajjan village and detained a resident after storming and searching his home. • Killing: At dawn on September 7th 2015, Raham Dawabsheh died from injuries sustained after his home was torched by Israeli settlers which killed her 18-month-old son and her husband who died of injuries and 4 year old critically injured in Duma village in Nablus as mentioned in the report of July 31st 2015. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:30, Israeli forces detained Shadia Zariqi (A resident of Nablus) as she was travelling to visits her brother in “Navat” prison. (ii) Israeli forces detained Amjad Daghlas (A University student) in Nablus. (iii) Israeli forces detained Wael Hanini in Beit Dajjan village. • Attack: At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Furiq fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads:

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: At 00:35, Israeli forces raided Kafil Harris as they escorted a group of Israeli settlers who stormed the area to visit a holy site then withdrew at 05:30.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: At 10:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 10:50.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • Flying Checkpoint: At 19:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Jallah and prevented residents from entering or exiting the area until 21:10 • Raid:

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Khirbiet Al-Deir village located in Taqou' and served a military order to halt construction on two homes owned by Atef Sabah and Ashraf Salem. (ii) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Taqou', stormed several homes, summoned 3 children: Yusef Sabah (16 years old), Mahmoud Salem Mahmoud (16 years old) and Samih Salim Sabah (16 years old) to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (iii) At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Nihalin village and summoned 2 residents: Mohammad Shakarneh and Iz Shakarneh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:40, Israeli forces detained Rabi' Shamroukh (A resident of Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem) as he was reporting to Israeli intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces detained Suhayeb Nabhan (A resident of Bethlehem) as he was applying for a Magnetic Identification card. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:30, a demonstration took place in Bi'r Ona area located near Beit Jallah protesting against Israeli military levelling of land and uprooting of Olive trees in order to complete the construction of the wall during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators in order to prevent them from reaching the demonstration site.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Hajjra village located in south Dura with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction. (ii) At 08:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Wadi Qabbun area junction (located in North Hebron). (iii) At 19:25, Israeli force set up a checkpoint in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron until 19:40. • <u>Raid:</u> At 16:40, Israeli forces raided Shiyoukh village and Al-Orub camp and clashed with several residents.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and Central Gaza.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • Attack: At 06:30 on September 6th 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in east Beit Hanoun.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
CENTRAL GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: At 07:15, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in east Al-Maghazi camp. • Detention: At 17:00, Israeli forces detained an unidentified resident who attempted to climb the border fence from east Al-Buriej camp into Israel.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
