<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Since September 3rd 2013, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Detention:</u> At 22:50, Israeli forces detained 9 residents including 3 children: Nur Shalabi (16 years old), Majdi Shalabi (15 years old), Qassem Al-Natsheh (17 years old), Mahmoud Jabr, Ali Jabr, Tarik Al-Zarba, Mohammad Shalabi, Abdallah Al-Sinjilaoi and Sahdi Farha as they stormed homes in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 10:40, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Za’im checkpoint detained Akram Tahawabna, a Presidential guard until 11:20. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma’ale Adumim for Sabbath holiday.

(ii) At 09:35, on September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30 and again at 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atara

	<p>bridge until 21:00.</p> <p>(ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Yabrud Village Bridge until 15:00.</p> <p>(iii) At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh until 21:00.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raid: At 00:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Saleh village, stormed 4 homes and summoned 4 residents: Abd Al-Tamimi, Mohammad Al-Tamimi, Mahmoud Al-Tamimi and Jihad Al-Tamimi to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:45. • Detention: At 14:25, Israeli forces positioned near Rantis village detained 2 residents: Mohammad Qaddah and Ribhi Al-Hafith for allegedly carrying a rifle. • Settler Violence: At 20:25, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles passing along the main road leading to Jalazun camp near “Bet El” settlement in Al-Bireh. • Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages for Sabbath holiday.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • Checkpoint: Since September 4th 2013, Israeli forces closed Barta’a checkpoint which is located near the wall gate and is the only entrance Barta’a Al-Shariqiya, Um Al-Rihan and Thahr Al-Malah villages which are all located behind the wall until September 8th 2013 and impeded the free flow of traffic for the Jewish holidays. • Flying Checkpoint: At 11:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Arraba and Al-Mansour village until 13:15. • Raid: At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Anin village, fired stun grenades towards several residents and detained 3 residents for allegedly attempting to climb the border fence into Israel. • Detention: Israeli forces detained 3 residents Ahmad Khadour, Mohammad Yassin and Mohammad Issa in Anin village. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoint: At 09:50 and again at 18:40, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Kafriyat road which connects Tulkarem and Qalqiliya until 13:40. • Raid: At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Attil until 03:35. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<p>the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun Atma and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Othman Ahmad near the entrance of Azzun Atma. • <u>Attack:</u> At 21:50, Israeli forces positioned near Azzun Atma fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to climb the wall into Israel. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction was halted in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement for Sabbath holiday.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:05 and again at 19:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 20:10. (ii) At 09:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf junction until 10:00. (iii) At 09:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at “Yitsahar” settlement junction located in North Huwwara until 11:50. (iv) At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at “Shave Shomron” settlement junction. • <u>Raid:</u> At 22:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq, clashed with its residents , temporarily detained 3 children: Omar Malitat (14 years old), Aram Hanini (14 years old) and Mohammad Hanini (15 years olds) and released them at 23:50.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 19:55, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at

<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:50 and again at 19:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 20:20. (ii) At 08:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) junction near A-Nuwei'ma village until 09:20. (iii) At 18:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Oja village junction until 19:15. (iv) At 19:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Fasayil village junction. (v) At 22:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ein Dweik village located in north Jericho. • <u>Raid:</u> At 20:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village until 23:00.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 11:30 on June 8th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area located in western Beit Sahur until 22:30. (ii) At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village junction until 02:30. (iii) At 23:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Za'tara until 02:30. • <u>Wall Construction:</u>

	<p>(i) Wall construction was halted in North West of Beit Jala town for Sabbath holiday.</p> <p>(ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.</p> <p>(iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.</p>
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Burj village. (ii) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Halhul bridge. (iii) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Farsh Al-Hawa area located in north Hebron. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir and Sheyoukh Al-Arab village then stormed 2 homes. (ii) At 00:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp and clashed with residents until 02:10. (iii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya until 04:15. (iv) At dawn on September 8th 2013, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, clashed with its residents as they stormed 2 homes and as a result caused Samah Abu Mariya to suffocate from tear gas inhalation and summoned Ahmad Hisham, Mohammad Abu Hisham (17 years old), Tarik Abu Hisham, Isam Abu Hisham and Khalil Abu Hisham to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ramadin area opened fire towards several labourers as they attempted to enter Israel and as a result injured 2 residents: Ali Au Zahra and Nabil Abu Ali leaving them hospitalised with contusions and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Nur Abu Ali near Al-Ramadin village.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces forced several merchant shop owners to close their shops in Al-Urub camp. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town for Jewish holiday.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed. • <u>Attack:</u> At 11:00 on September 5th 2013, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> • Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry of residents and tourists. • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
