JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikse villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikse village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 15:00, Israeli forces closed Jaba’ checkpoint located along the road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho then reopened it later. • <u>Detention:</u> At 20:30, Israeli forces detained five residents: Nidal Sinuqrut, Ziyad Mahlous, Khamis Ayash, Shuqri Nasr Al-Din and Shaqer Nasr Al-Din on Salah-Al-Din road in Jerusalem. • <u>Attack:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Thuri neighbourhood and Silwan in Jerusalem {during the funeral of Mohammed Sinokrot (15 years old)} fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of September 8th 2013, Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ibzi’ village. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Silwad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Ni’ meh village until 15:15. (ii) At 16:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Mazra’a Al-Gharbiya village temporarily detained the child: Shu’ayb Shartih (13 years old) then released him later. (iii) At 19:00 and again 02:45, Israeli forces raided Silwad, temporarily detained 2 children: Ramzi Hamad (8 years old) and Abdel-Fatah Hamad (7 years old) then released them at a later time, stormed several homes, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 03:20. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli force detained two residents: Asef Hamad and Imad Hamad in Silwad.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:35, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched 3 homes and an Athletic center and as a result injured the child: Imad Hirz-Allah (12 years old) leaving him hospitalised with contusions and temporarily detained Mahmoud Ma’moun Amarneh (13 years old) then released them at a later time and withdrew at 21:50. (ii) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Jenin and its camps, stormed several homes and detained two residents. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 09:30, Israeli forces positioned at “Movo Dotan” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jenin-Tulkarem temporarily detained Mansour Bakr then released him at 12:00.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrances of Bardalah and Tayassir villages. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:15, Israeli forces raided Tamoun.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 09:30 and again at 20:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:50. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:20, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Ghusun until 10:40. (ii) At 01:30, Israeli force raided Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem, stormed a home then withdrew at 03:40.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (ii) At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Burin Village Bridge until 11:30. (ii) At 14:45, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jama’in until 15:10. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:40 on September 8th 2014, Israeli forces raided Nablus and stormed Abdul-Mugith Al-Anssar School. (ii) At 23:25, Israeli forces raided Assirah Al-Shimaliya, Tassid and Beit Umrin until 01:20. (iii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq, stormed 11 homes, and temporarily detained two residents: Zakariya Khasman and Moath Nassasrah then withdrew at 04:10. (iv) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qalil village.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with

(ii) At 06:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 07:15. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village, stormed and searched a home, detained two residents then withdrew at 02:30. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On September 7th 2014, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge detained Tawfiq Ra'aya (A resident of Jenin) as he was returning from Jordan. (ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Marwan Jarhoud and Mohammad Jarhoud in Al-Oja village.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the southeastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iii) At 18:55, Israeli forces raided Taqou' until 22:20. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Abdallah Abiyat in Bethlehem.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

(ii) At 14:55, Israeli forces positioned near “Krumi Tsur” settlement temporarily detained 3 children: Mohammad Abu Mariya (16 years old), Muwafaq Abu Mariya (14 years old) and Moyayad Abu Mariya (13 years old) the released them at 17:30.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.

<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients. • <u>Attack:</u> At 05:30, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Waha beach in West Beit Lahiya, detained 4 fishermen and confiscated a fishing boat. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained four fishermen: Ahmad Al-Sultan, Baha Al-Sultan, Siyam Al-Sultan and Tariq Al-Sultan off the shores of Al-Waha beach in West Beit Lahiya.

GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents , students , tourists and businessmen (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA. • <u>Killing:</u> On September 8th 2014, Mohammad Al-Rabatti (A resident of Rafah) died at a hospital in Egypt of serious injuries sustained from the Israeli Military assault on the Gaza strip.
