JERUSALEM	 Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to increase restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city and prevented civilians from other Palestinian districts from entering the city, except those holding special permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. Detention: At 17:55, Israeli forces detained the civilian, Samer Al Balboul a resident of Bethlehem, in Jerusalem under the pretext of not having required permit to enter Israel. Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Wall Construction: Wall construction has resumed in the areas north and south			
	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. Flying checkpoints: At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Al Sudan village, searching civilians and vehicles. Raids: At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Reema village, during which confrontations 			

	ensued between civilians and Israeli forces.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	 Demonstrations: At 13:25, Palestinian and International Peace Activists demonstrated in Al Nabi Saleh village, protesting against settler violence, confiscation of land for Hilmesh settlement. In response Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of the village, firing Tear gas grenades towards demonstrators, as a result several demonstrators suffocated as a result of Tear gas inhalation and detained a child. At 13:40, Palestinian and International Peace activists demonstrated in Bilin village protesting against the construction of the Wall, during which confrontations ensued between demonstrators and Israeli forces. Several demonstrators suffocated as a result of tear gas inhalation. At 13:40, Palestinian and International Peace Activists demonstrated in Nilin, protesting against the construction of the wall, during which
	confrontations ensued between demonstrators and Israeli Forces, injuring a civilian after being hit with a gas grenade leaving him with contusions,
	and several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
	• <u>Detentions:</u>
	(i) Israeli forces detained Islam Al Tamimi 16 years old in Al Nabi Saleh village.
	 Wall Construction: Wall construction has resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
	Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan.
JENIN	 Raid: At 22:50, Israeli forces raided Silat Al Thahir village until 23:10. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	 <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00.
	• Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road.
	(iii) Since 20:00 on September 4 th 2011, the Israeli army closed the entrance to Izbat Shoufat village with dirt mounds and cement blocks.
TULKAREM	 <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to severely restrict Palestinian access at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic.
	Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted
	 special Israeli permits. Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route has resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.

• Closure of Roads:

- (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun.
- (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second *Intifada*, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Qaddumvillage, searching civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 11:40, Israeli forces setup a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun town, searching civilians and vehicles.
- (iii) At 15:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entranceof Jit village, searching civilians and vehicles.
- (iv) At 17:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint on Wadi Qana road (connecting Qalqilya and Salfit), searching civilians and vehicles.
- (v) At 17:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Hija and Al fonduk villages, searching civilians and vehicles.
- (vi) At 22:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Al Nabi Elyas ,located on Qalqilya Nablus main road, searching civilians and vehicles.
- (vii) At 23:10, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Lafiq.
- (viii) At 23:25, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Kafr Kaddum and Hija villages, searching civilians and vehicles.
- Raids: At 19:30, Israeli forces raided Azzun town, fired flash grenades near the eastern part of the town and withdrew at 20:30..

• Detentions:

At 16:00, Israeli forces detained 4 children, Saleh Mustafa 16 years old, Iham Saleh 16 years old, Wissam Radwan 14 years old and Yazan Radwan 15 years old near Al Nabi Elyas village on the Qalqilya Nablus main road because the allegedly stone an Israeli Military Jeep.

• Settler Violence:

At 19:45,a group of Israeli settlers from "Karni Shamron" settlement stoned civilian vehicles as they were passing near a junction on Qalqilya – Nablus main road.

• Demonstration:

At 13:30, Palestinian and International peace activists demonstrated in Kafr Qaddum village protesting against the closure of the eastern entrance of the village. Israeli forces prevented demonstrators from reaching the demonstration site.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras 'Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

	 Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. Checkpoints: (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and 02:00 only to residents of the neighbourhood. (ii) At 'Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint. Flying checkpoints: (i) At 12:00, The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the junction of Salim village searching civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 19:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint between Nablus city and Asira Al Shamaliya village. Raids: (i) At 00:45, the Israeli army raided Bietavillage, during which confrontations ensued between civilians and Israeli troops, and withdrew at 06:50. Settler Violence: At 15:30, a group of Israeli settlers entered civilian land in Qassri village and cut limbs of approximately 40 olive trees and withdrew after intervention from Israeli forces.
SALFIT	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds and cement blocks the northern entrance to Bruqin town. The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years. Checkpoints: At 18:10 the Israeli army continues to increase restrictions on Zatara checkpoint, obstructing the free flow of traffic. Flying Checkpoint: At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Al Dik village. At 15:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Isstya village, searching civilians and vehicles. At 18:55, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of

	Qarawat Bani Hassan town.

	(i) At 12:40, Israeli forces raided Deir Isstya town until 13:20.

	• Wall Construction: Wall construction has resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement Emmanuel.
	Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al 'Auja village with cement blocks.

- (iii) At 18:35, a group of Israeli settlers from "Karyat Arba" settlement near Al bowiera area opened fire towards a vehicle belonging to Mohammad Sultan damaging the vehicle.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Dhahiriya town.
