JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 15:00, Israeli forces closed Jaba’ checkpoint located along the road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho then reopened it later. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces raided Kafr Aqab village and Samir Amis area in north Jerusalem. (ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces raided Qutna village and clashed with several residents. (iii) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram, stormed a home then withdrew at 03:30. • <u>Detention:</u> On September 9th 2014, Israeli forces detained Khalil Abu Al-Hawa in Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram entrance fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned near Salah Al-Din road in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained Mohammad Al-Hadad (13 years old) then released him later. • <u>Injury:</u> At 20:00 on September 8th 2014, Israeli forces assaulted and injured two

	<p>residents Qasem Burqan and Adnan Al-Salfati in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem (during the funeral of the child Mohammad Sinuqrut as mentioned in the previous report).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 13:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash'al until 17:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Deir Ghassaneh, clashed with several residents as they stormed a building, and detained a resident then withdrew at 11:00. (ii) At 14:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, clashed with several residents as they stormed a gas station, detained a resident then withdrew at 14:45. (iii) At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Mazra'a Al-Gharbiya, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 03:30. (iv) At 03:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Amari camp in Al-Bireh city, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home and as a result killed a resident then detained another residents and withdrew at 05:00. • <u>Killing:</u> Israeli force killed Issa Khaled Al-Qatari (22 years old) during their raid into Al-Amari camp in Al-Bireh city. • <u>Detention:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Alaa Mohammad Al-Barghouthi in Deir Ghassaneh. (ii) Israeli forces detained Ma'moun Awad (A resident of Qalandiya camp) in Al-Bireh city. (iii) Israeli forces detained Alaa Khallatiya in Al-Amari camp in Al-Bireh city.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Ya'bad until 15:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:35, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad until 22:20. • <u>Installation of Military Post:</u> At 16:20, Israeli forces installed 20 tents on agricultural land near "Dotan" checkpoint located in south Ya'bad until 22:20.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages

	<p>near “Aveni Hivits”.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 10:20, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 10:35. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Shufah and Izbit Shufa villages and impeded the free flow of traffic for vehicles and residents except for the residents of Shufa village. (ii) At 16:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jabarah junction (located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Qalqiliya). • <u>Raid:</u> At 16:20, Israeli force raided Tulkarem. • <u>Detention:</u> At 01:30 on September 9th 2014, Israeli forces detained Ziyad Al-Taliya during their raid into Al-Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem as mentioned in the previous report. • <u>Attack:</u> At 11:50, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Zieta fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun, impeded the free flow of traffic after closing the entrance gate. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 22:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 11:10, Israeli forces raided Izbit Suliman, temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers then withdrew at 12:05. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Huwarah

(iv) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Hatab, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:00. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned at Huwarah checkpoint detained Moath Loai Mohammad (A resident of Askar camp in Nablus). (ii) Israeli forces detained Haytham Suliman Odeh in Deir Al-Hatab.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Harris village until 12:20.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00 and again at 17:00,19:00 and again at 22:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 00:10. (ii) At 22:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fasayil village. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Hamrah checkpoint detained Assad Abu Arrah (A resident of Tubas). (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Hamrah checkpoint detained Oday Rahwan Shahrouri (A resident of Tubas).
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the southeastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.

(ii) At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jinata. (iii) At 20:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Za’tara and Beit Ta’mar until 22:00. (iv) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Taqou’ until 22:40. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Harmalah village until 22:40. (ii) At 03:35, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and summoned Ahmad Al-Hurani to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiw Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and

(ii) At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents and as a result injured Ishaq Shalladah leaving him hospitalised then withdrew at 04:35. (iii) At 03:25, Israeli forces raided Halhul until 05:00. (ii) Israeli forces detained Ali Adi and Mohammad Adi in Safa village. (iii) Israeli forces detained Khaled Sabarneh in Beit Ummar. (iv) Israeli forces detained Salah Hassinah in Al-Urub camp.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
KHAN YUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Killing:</u> On September 9th 2014, the child Rahaf Abu Jama' (5 years old) {A resident of Bani Suhaylah} died at a hospital in Egypt of injuries sustained from the Israeli Military Assault on the Gaza strip.

RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Closure of Crossing Points :(i) Yasser ‘Arafat International Airport remains closed.(ii) Rafah (<i>Al ‘Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents , students , tourists and businessmen(iii) Sufa Crossing is closed.(iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
