JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to increase restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city and prevented civilians from other Palestinian districts from entering the city, except those holding special permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On 10.09.2011, Israeli forces raided Anata and arrested 1 civilian. (ii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram. (iii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Biddu and handed (Rabea al Khdoor) an order to meet Israeli intelligence. (iv) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya refugee camp. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On 30.08.2011, Israeli forces arrested Mahmmud Al-Haq from Anata. (ii) The detained in Anata: Basil Ibrahim. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction stopped in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma’ale Adumim due to the Sabbath holiday.

<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Betunyiah, during which confrontations ensued between civilians and Israeli forces. (iv) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Mazraa Al-Sharqiyah, Shkhedem and Kobar, and handed Ahmad Rumana an order to report to Israeli inelegance. • Settler Violence: At 17:00 Israeli settlers from Halamish settlement and stoned civilian vehicles. • Wall Construction: Wall construction stopped in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages because of the Sabbath holiday.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • Flying checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:40, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at Al-Araqah, searching people and cars. (ii) At 18:55 Israeli forces setup a checkpoint near Yabed, searching people and cars. (iii) At 19:30 Israeli forces setup a checkpoint between Araqah and Yabed, searching people and cars. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

Israeli forces raided Aqaba village. (ii) At 00:15, Israeli forces raided Tubas city. (iii) At 02:10, Israeli forces Fargah village until 02:40
<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) Since 20:00 on September 4th 2011, the Israeli army closed the entrance to Izbet Shoufat village with dirt mounds and cement blocks. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to severely restrict Palestinian access at ‘Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying checkpoint: At 14:15, Israeli forces setup a checkpoint at Kufar Lubbad and Tulkarem city, searching people and cars. • Raids: At 22:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Lubad until 23:20. • Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route stopped in

	<p>the area surrounding Jubara village due to the Sabbath holiday. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of ‘Azzun. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Haja village, searching people and cars. (ii) At 09:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Qalqilya city, searching people and cars. (iii) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jinsafout village, searching people and cars. (iv) At 18:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Azzun town, searching people and cars. (v) At 23:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Funduk village, searching people and cars. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras ‘Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction stopped in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma’ale Shomron settlement due to the Sabbath holiday.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and 02:00 only to residents of the neighbourhood. (ii) At ‘Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Iraq Burin village, searching people and cars. (ii) At 11:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Furik town, searching people and cars. (iii) At 17:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Nablus city and Assira town and forced several citizens to step down from their cars and undress during the search and detention. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 18:05, a group of Israeli settlers entered civilian land at the eastern outskirts of Burin village and threw stones towards the homes of Bashier Ziben and Barsale Eid; Israeli forces evacuated the settlers later on. • At 21:00, a group of Israeli settlers stoned cars near Hwara checkpoint, damaging Ahmad Hamed's car.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds and cement blocks the northern entrance to Bruqin town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (iii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 18:10 the Israeli army continues to increase restrictions on Zatarah checkpoint, obstructing the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Skaka village. (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Kufor Al-Deek and Deir Balout towns, searching civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Qarawat Bani Hassan town. (iv) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Bruqin and Qarawat Bani Zaid, searching people and cars. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Kufal Hareth and Deir Isstya. <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction has resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement Emmanuel.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al 'Auja village with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area. And from 23:20 to 23:50, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint while searching the surrounding area. (ii) Israeli forces continue to restrict access at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-'Auja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:20, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho city.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israeli army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 <i>dunums</i> of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 20:40, the Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Al Nashash Junction, searching civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:35, Israeli forces raided Abaidyiah and Deir Salah. (ii) At 16:45, Israeli forces raided Al Khadir village.. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction stopped northwest of Beit Jala town due to the Sabbath holiday.
Hebron	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Fawar, searching civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 21:05, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance of Hebron city, searching civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance of

	<p>Al-Thahryiah town, searching civilians and vehicles.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:45, Israeli forces raided Hebron City. (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Dura town. (iii) At 23:25, Israeli forces raided Samou village and handed 3 demolition orders to Salem Rawashda, Qateba Rawashda and Ramadan Abu Awad. (iv) At 02:00. Israeli forces raided Karza village. (v) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, (i) <u>Detentions:</u> Israeli forces detained Fares Yaser Eid Aweiwe in Hebron. (ii) Israeli forces detained 17 year-old Ali Badaawi Ekhilil, Nadeem Ekhleel in Beit Ummar town. • <u>Provocation of Palestinian Forces:</u> At 16:50, Israeli forces detained 4 customs police officers near “Qiryat Arba” settlement and released them after military liaison intervention at 18:30. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:20, a group of Israeli settlers prevented citizens from passing through Shuhada’ street in Hebron’s Old City. (ii) At 19:30, a group of Israeli settlers, in Tal Al-Rumaida neighbourhood in Hebron’s Old City assaulted Taisir Abu Aisha and beat his family members, bruising one child and 2 women. (iii) At 19:50, a group of Israeli settlers stoned citizens in the Old City market, injuring and bruising Amjad Ashour; he was hospitalized. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> At 10:20, Palestinian and Israeli peace activists marched to the agricultural land of Beit Ummar town, located close to "Karmi Tsur" settlement. They protested against land confiscation and settler attacks and demanded access for citizens to their land. Clashed ensued with the occupation forces as they tried to prevent the demonstrators from reaching their land; several injuries were reported, including 'Ali' Ayad Awad, bruised from severe beating; he was hospitalized for treatment. Two 2 international activists were also detained. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction stopped in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Dhahiriya town .

GAZA STRIP

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 10 August 2011 at 21:00. • <u>Ceasefire Violation:</u> Israeli Military tanks violated the ceasefire by conducting raids and artillery shelling as well as the detention of three children in Khan Younis District. Also, Israeli naval vessels fired towards Palestinian fishermen at sea off the Gaza shores and arrested 8 fishermen (2 children among them) in North Gaza district. • Ceasefire violation: Palestinian groups opened fire towards the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) was closed. • <u>Fire Attack:</u> At 07:00, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards fishermen boats while chasing them off the Suddanyiah shore, west of Beit Lahyiah; 8 fishermen (including 2 minors) were detained, and 2 boats confiscated. • <u>Detention:</u> • Eight detainees at sea are: 17 year-old Mohammed Baker, 16 year-old Adnan Baker, Mohammed, Hassan Baker and their sons, khader, Jafar and Mohammed. • <u>Palestinian Attack:</u> On the evening of September 10th 2011, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p style="text-align: center;">Khan Younis</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids:</u> On the evening of 10 September, 2011, several Israeli tanks raided East of Qarara town, accompanied by helicopters; they opened heavy gunfire towards agricultural land and detained 3 minors. • <u>Fire Attacks:</u> On the evening of 10 September, 2011, Israeli forces fired 2 artillery shells from the Green Line towards East Abasan. • <u>Detention:</u> Three detainees east of Qararah are: Ahmad abu Lahyia, Ahmed abu Haleb, Mussa abu Lahyia.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> • Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed. • Attack: On the morning of September 9th 2011, Israeli forces opened fire towards agricultural Land and a civilian home located near Yasser Arafat International Airport east of Rafah.
