(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city Attack: At 11:30, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and injured Issa Jahajuj (15 years) and Ali Al-qam suffocating from tear gas inhalation. Home Demolition: On September 10 th 2012, Israeli forces served demolition notices to demolish 6 homes owned by Siyam, Abu Hudwan, Baydoun, Hamdan and Abu Aram families in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem for allegedly not having proper licencing. Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar camp junction.
- **Raids:** At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Surif.

ALL DISTRITS	 At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 23 June 2012 at 24:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Central Gaza. Israeli Naval Vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza. Israeli aircrafts broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles towards Central Gaza which injured 9 residents including 4 children.

NORTHERN GAZA	 <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for humanitarian assistance, journalists and international access. <u>Attack:</u> At 21:00, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishermen off the shores of Beit Lahiya.
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
CENTRAL GAZA	 Raid: At 06:00, Israeli forces escorting military bulldozers raided Al-Bureij camp in Deir Al-Balah and opened fire as they levelled a plot of agricultural land. Injury: At dawn on September 10th 2012 an Israeli airstrike on Al-Nasiryat camp injured 9 residents including 4 children: Hamdan Abu Khlil, Inad Abu Khlil (2 years), Jasir Abu Khlil (5 years), Suhayb Abu Khlil (4 years), Rima Kabaja (11 years), Salam Abu Farih, Ghassan Abu Nabhan, Haniya Kabaja and Nur Abu Naban.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is open for the exit of patients, students, passengers with permits and International aid for school students. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of humanitarian supplies, cooking gas, truckloads of wheat and Livestock feed, fuel supplies and construction material for internationally funded projects.
