<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Nafaq area in Biddu. • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Qutnah village and clashed with several residents during which Israeli forces opened fire and launched stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents: Mohammad Shamasneh (19 years old) and Mohammad Taha (18 years old). • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:50, Israeli forces near Jaba ’junction opened fire and launched stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 19:32, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Aqbat neighbourhood near Al-Ram opened fire and launched stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 22:32, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Qutna village opened fire and launched stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 22:53, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Al-Juz, Ein Al-Lawzah and Al-Basta neighbourhoods in Silwan opened fire and launched stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of September 11th 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in

	<p>Abu Dis town.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p>

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Sinjil. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Deir Abu Mash’al village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 14:20, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 13:50, Israeli settlers stoned residents and vehicles near “Halamish” settlement.

(ii) At 10:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Yamoun, opened fire and launched stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents and stormed an Aluminium factory owned by Raed Abu Hassan. (iii) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Dan and detained three residents then withdrew at 14:22. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Adel Abed (17 years old), Faraj Jaffar (16 year old) and Mohammad Moyad Abed (16 years old).

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:23, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Bazariya village junction.

(iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:10 and again at 14:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint Azzun junction until 23:00. (ii) At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 15:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 20:49, Israeli forces raided Al-Jiftlik village and detained Saddam Ka'abneh (25 years old). • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 15:45, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over 2 residents: Fayez Odat and Yasser Odat {residents of Aqbat Al-Jabr camp) near the Dead Sea junction and as a result left one them injured with a broken leg.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiwn Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna located near the wall gate. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Nabi Yunis area in Halhul. ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients. • Attack: On the morning of September 9th 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach in west Beit Lahiya.

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.

(ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents , students , tourists and businessmen (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
