- At 24:00 on September 12th 2013, Israeli forces closed all checkpoints and entry crossing into the West Bank for "Jewish Passover" holiday and prevented residents, labourers including those with entry permits from entering Jerusalem and Israel with the exception of Diplomatic mission and emergency health cases with prior coordination until 24:00 on September 14th 2013.

The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Detainees Update

of Palestinian detainees in Israeli prisons have increased to 5200 detainees spread across 17 detention centers which include 220 children, 13 women, 13 Members of Parliament, 146 detainees detained without charges and 78 detainees imprisoned since 1994.
