WEST BANK

Since 24:00 on September 12th 2013, Israeli forces closed all checkpoints and entry crossing into the West Bank for "Jewish Passover "holiday and prevented residents, labourers including those with entry permits from entering Jerusalem and Israel with the exception of Diplomatic mission and emergency health cases with prior coordination until 24:00 on September 14th 2013.

	and Ibrahim Sbieh.
	• <u>Demonstration</u> : At 13:40, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma'sara village
	protesting against the construction of the wall during which Israeli forces fired tear
	gas grenades towards residents thus preventing them from reaching the
	demonstration site and suffocated several demonstrators from tear gas inhalation.
	• <u>Wall Construction</u> :
	(i) Wall construction has continued in North West of Beit Jala town.
	(ii)On May 1 st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction

	near Betar village. (iii) On July 21 st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
	Closure:
	 (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. 	(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
	 (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

On the evening of September 13th 2013, Israeli forces raided Safa village, clashed with its residents and assaulted Nablia Abu Daya.
	 <u>Temporary Detention:</u> (i) Since 24:00, on September 12th 2013, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at the entrances and crossing leading to the old city of Hebron and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to allow Israeli settlers to perform Talmudic rituals in Al-Ibrahimi mosque. (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron and Lebrar to perform the other settlement of the shift Almost Provide the shift Provide the
	 of Hebron temporarily detained the child Ahmad Rjub (10 years old) and released him at 12:10. <u>Attack:</u> On the evening of September 13th 2013, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Fuwar camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
	• <u>Obstruction on Places of Worship:</u> At 17:00 on September 13 th 2013, Israeli forces closed the entrances to Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers in order to allow Israeli settlers to perform Talmudic rituals for the Jewish holiday.
	• <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.

NORTHERN GAZA	• <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	 <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	 <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
