WEST BANK

JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At dawn on September 14th 2014, Israeli forces raided Hizma village detained a resident after storming his home and confiscated money and Jewellery.
 - (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ijzah, temporarily detained several residents then released him later.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces detained three residents including a child: Thaer Abu Sneineh, Ahmad Abu Aliya and Khadr Abu Farha (16 years old) in the old city of Jerusalem.
 - (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Al-Natshah (A resident of Jerusalem) in Al-Aqsa Mosque compound.
 - (iii) On September 15th 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Mohammad Abbassi and Mohammad Boujat in Silwan neighbourhood.
 - (iv) On September 15th 2014, Israeli forces detained two children: Mohammad Muhsien (15 years old) and Layth Al-Husseini (15 years old) in Shu’fat neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
 - (v) Israeli forces detained Nassrin Salah Al-Din in Hizma village.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:** At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers during which Israeli forces assaulted and injured a woman as she attempted to prevent a settler from dumping waste into the drinking fountain.
- **Wall Gates:**

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • Raid: At dawn on September 15th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city and detained a resident. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:40 on September 15th 2014, Israeli forces detained Sharhabil Hassuneh during their raid into Beituniya as mentioned in the previous report. (ii) Israeli forces detained Itiraf Al-Rimawi in Al-Bireh city.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • Detention: At 15:50 on September 14th 2014, Israeli forces detained Ismail Othman (A resident of Tulkarem) during their raid into Jenin. • Attack: At 00:10, Israeli forces positioned near Zubaba village fired flash grenades into the sky and as a result set fire to agricultural land during which Palestinian Civil Defence forces extinguished the fire.

(ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Bardalah village and performed Military exercises between homes in the village. • Confiscation of Property: At 07:10, Israeli forces confiscated an agricultural tractor and an Electricity generator owned by Jamal Odeh a resident of Tamoun and confiscated the Identification card of Saud Bani Odeh in east Tamoun.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”. • Checkpoint: At 16:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: At 18:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Lid until 18:40.

(ii) At 22:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Al-Fandūq and Hajja villages, detained a resident, temporarily detained three residents then released him later. • <u>Raid:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Izbit Al-Tabib while escorting several land Israeli Registration employees and levelled a plot of land owned by Abu Haniya family at the entrance of the village and gave the land owners a Month notice to appeal the decision then withdrew at 14:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Anas Q'shou'a (A resident of Taqat Al-Hatab village) in the area between Al-Fandūq and Hajja villages. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun temporarily detained two residents: Yahya Shabitta and Mustafa Shabitta then released them at 17:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 08:35, Israeli intensified their restrictions at Huwarah checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic as they searched and inspected several vehicles and residents using bomb-sniffing dogs until 10:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Nablus and Balatah camp, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 04:20.
<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.

JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the South entrance of Jericho until 17:10. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Hamrah checkpoint temporarily detained Haytham Al-Shalladlah (A National Security Force officer) {A resident of Al-Jiflik village} as he was accompanying his wife and child then released him later. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 23:10, Israeli forces served demolition orders for two barracks owned by Hayel Basharat and Mahmoud Basharat near Al-Humrah checkpoint and gave them until October 20th 2014 to implement the demolition.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.

(iii) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Sharafah area located in east Husan village and impeded the free flow of traffic for alleged firing at an Israeli settler vehicle. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
