WEST BANK

Closure:

- Since September 13th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at (i) the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers in Al-Agsa mosque compound because of the Jewish New Year.
- The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in (ii) the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

Closure of Main Roads:

- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village.
- The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (ii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 21:25, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until reopening it
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 14:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Rafat Village Bridge.

Attack:

- (i) At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram's north junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning (as they protested the continued attack from Israeli settlers, Israeli military and Police officers towards worshipers inside Al-Aqsa mosque) and again at 19:00 confrontations continued and as a result injured 3 residents including 2 children: Basel Al-Salaymeh (17 years old), Mahmoud Sharabati (15 years old) and Qusay Al-Matour leaving them hospitalised.
- (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Anata fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Eisawiya village fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured a resident as they detained him and also injured the child Sali Muhiesin (13 years old) as she was near the village entrance.
- tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (v) At 19:25, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Quds University in Abu Dis

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Khan Yunis and injured a Palestinian Gunman.

(ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decisions.
CENTRAL GAZA	Detention: At 20:00, Israeli forces detained two unidentified resident in South East Dier Al-Balah village as they were attempting to climb the border fence into Israel.
KHAN YUNIS	Attack: At 10:30, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards Abbassan Al-Kabirah and as a result injured a Palestinian Gunman.
