(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to

(ii) At 23:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, stormed and searched a home. • <u>Obstruction of Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of September 16th 2013, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) At 09:35 on September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north entrance to Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, stormed 2 homes, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 03:20. (ii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Abboud, detained 2 residents including a National Security officer and summoned several residents to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Abdel Aziz Jabarin and Thaer Dawlat in Beituniya. (ii) At 18:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Abdel Karim Al-Hussieni and Ahmad Sharakat. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 20:50, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles passing along the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad.

Mohammad Abdel Latif (detained), Nidal Mir’I and Jamil Sa’di. • <u>Killing:</u> Israeli forces killed Islam Al-Tubassi in Jenin camp. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abdel Latif in Jenin camp. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jamalat crossing temporarily detained Amer Gharibiya, a resident of Sanur and released him at a later time. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 06:45 on September 16th 2013, Israeli forces raided Khirbiet Makhul village which is located in the North Jordan valley, demolished 10 homes owned by Mohammad Bashirat, Ahmad Bashirat, Mahmoud Bashirat, Yusef Abdallah, Burhan Bashirat, Hussien Bashirat, Ahmad Bani Odeh, Yunis Abu Hilweh, Yusef Abu Hilweh and Hassan including several Barack’s and agricultural dens and declared the area a closed military zone, did not allow journalists or medical staff from the International Red Cross to enter the area, forced residents out of their homes and seized a supplies truck for alleged military training in the area. (ii) At 09:40, Israeli forces raided Ibziq village located in north Tubas summoned several residents’ eviction orders: Ahmad Sawafta and Musa Al-Huroub giving them until 05:00 until 21:30 of September 17th 2013 in order to conduct military training in the area. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces temporarily detained Ahmad Bani Odeh and Khalaf Bani Odeh in Khirbeit Al-Makhoul and seized the vehicle they were driving.

The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
