#### **WEST BANK**

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

#### • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

#### • Raid:

- (i) On the evening of September 16<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram and detained a resident.
- (ii) At dawn on September 17<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and stormed several homes.

#### • Detention:

- (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance gate of Al-Aqsa mosque compound detained Kadijah Abu Khuwies (A student of the Islamic school of Al-Aqsa mosque compound) as she was attempting to attend school.
- (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces detained Wa'ed Hudayb in Jerusalem.
- (iii) At 15:55, Israeli forces detained Raed Taqatqa (A resident of Bethlehem) in Jerusalem
- (iv) Israeli forces detained Muhanad Al-Ghazawneh in Al-Ram.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 21:40, Israeli forces positioned at Shu'fat checkpoint temporarily detained three residents (2 children and a Palestinian Intelligence officer): Fadi Khalil, Attiyah Asakrah (17 years old) and Yusef Asakrah (12 years old) then released them at 00:15.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 08:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers as well as broke off several Olive tree limbs, which are planted around Al-Aqsa mosque.

- (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located at the North entrance of Beit Sahur until 11:30.
- (ii) At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahur until 20:10.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 10:20, Israeli forces raided Beit Jallah, set up a checkpoint then withdrew at 11:40.
- (ii) At 11:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Doha until 12:30.
- (iii)At 11:35, Israeli forces raided Taqou', clashed with several residents until 16:40.
- (iv)At 03:50, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and Al-Duhisheh camp in Bethlehem, summoned two residents: Raghed Shamroukh and Ahmad Al-Jaffari to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 06:00.
- <u>Detention:</u> At 08:20 on September 16<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained Eid Kamal as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon.

#### • Attack:

- (i) At 15:45, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near "Murad Water Park" in North Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Hisham Abu Mariya (A resident of Hebron).

#### • <u>Closure:</u>

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

#### **HEBRON**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.

- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) On September 4<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiwn Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna locat6ed near the wall gate.

#### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Einun village junction until 09:30.
- (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction until 19:40.

#### Raid:

- (i) At 02:00 on September 16<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'im and detained three residents.
- (ii) At 22:20, Israeli forces raided Ithna, stormed and searched a merchant shop.
- (iii)At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Sammit and detained a resident after storming his home.

#### Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained three residents: Mursi Hamidat, Osama Manasrah and Mohammad Hamidat in Bani Na'im.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Abdel-Hamid Al-Sharawneh in Deir Sammit.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Tabaqa village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

# At 19:00 on August 26<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Palestinian Gunmen broke the ceasefire agreement by lunching projectiles towards the Green Line.
