JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Since September 13th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers in Al-Aqsa mosque compound because of the Jewish New Year. ○ The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. ○ The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. • The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 21:25, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until reopening it later. • On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bir Nabala. • At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya, occupied the rooftops of several homes and converted them into Military posts, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and as a result injured an unidentified resident and detained a child. • At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, clashed with several residents and as a result injured a journalist. • At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Jib village and clashed with several residents. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • At 15:10, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Kabsa area in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 6 residents: Abdallah Far’oun, Ahmad Abu

	<p>Jafar, Jamal Salameh, Ahmad Mustafa, Alaa Abdallah and Ali Muhsien leaving them hospitalised with contusions.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 15:45, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at Shu'fat checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned at Shu'fat checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Anata fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> • At 10:30, Israeli forces detained two residents: Shadi Abu Teir and Muhanad Abu Tier in Sur Bahar village. • At 21:30, Israeli forces detained two children: Mahmoud Sadarah (17 years old) and Mahmoud Abu Al-Hawa (17 years old). • At dawn on September 17th 2015, Israeli forces positioned at Bab Al-Majlis gate (A Main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem) detained the child Nabil Sader (13 years old). • At dawn on September 17th 2015, Israeli forces detained two children: Mu'taz Sa'aydeh and Ahmad Sa'aydeh in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood. • At dawn on September 17th 2015, Israeli forces detained three children: Muhi-Al-Din Barakat, Nassar Amireh and Mu'taz Abu Dabsh in Sur Bahar village. • Israeli forces detained Majd Darwish (16 years old) in Al-Eisawiya village. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 13:00, Israeli forces stormed Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem and served military orders for the demolition of 3 homes owned by Mas'oud Aliyana , Odah family and Bashir family. • <u>Obstruction of Medical Sector:</u> At 23:30, Israeli forces stormed Al-Maqassid hospital in Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem, searched the children's section and stormed several other rooms for alleged search for two residents who were injured during confrontations. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces and Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers during which Israeli forces assaulted and injured two Mosque guards: Hamza Nimr and Mowaqif Hamami leaving them hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 10:30, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Al-Rahma Islamic mosque in Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> • The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. • The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajraa village located in south Dura with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Beit Announ village. (ii) At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Halhoul Bridge until 21:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on September 16th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Awwa, stormed and searched Bassam Al-Masalma's home as they attempted to detain him who was injured as he tried to escape detention after falling and fracturing his hip. (ii) At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed, and searched a home. (iii) At dawn on September 17th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, stormed and searched several homes, detained four residents including two children and summoned Haydar Abu Mariya to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:00, Israeli forces detained Eliyas Al-Ja'bari in Jabar neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron after spraying pepper spray onto his face. (ii) Israeli forces detained four residents: Muhanad Abu Mariya (15 years old), Raed Al-Salibi, Mohammad Abu Mariya and Yahya Abu Mariya in Beit Ummar. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On September 16th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Khilat Al-Miya and Al-Far'iya villages located in east Yatta and served military orders for the demolition of four structures (1 home and 3 tents) owned ny Mohammad

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
