	• Wall Construction: Wall construction stopped in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. Raids: At 13:25, Israeli forces raided Arraba and Yaabad village. At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Fahma village. Detentions: At 13:00, Israeli forces detained Murad Malysha from Jabaa town, after he was perused by Israeli forces while he driving his taxi on the road between Nablus and Bir Al Basha. Settler Violence: At 10:00, Israeli settlers entered an evacuated outpost (Homesh) and set fire to several trees. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	 <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00. <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 14:40, Israeli settlers entered an area near Ein Helwah in the Jordan Valley, and erected several tents.
TULKAREM	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. Since 20:00 on September 4th 2011, the Israeli army closed the entrance to Izbat Shoufat village with dirt mounds and cement blocks. Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to severely restrict Palestinian access at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. Flying checkpoints: At 11:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Kafriat road (between Tulkarem and Qalqilyia), searching people and cars until 12:50. Raids: At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Shweikeh neighbourhood and surveyed the area near the wall. Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route stopped in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.
QALQILYA	Closure of Roads: Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun. In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i> , the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. Flying checkpoints: - At 13:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Azzoun town, searching civilians and vehicles.

- (ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Al-Nabi Elias village, searching civilians and vehicles.
- (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Kufar Laqef village, searching civilians and vehicles.
- (iv) At 22:30, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Jett village, searching civilians and vehicles.
- Raids: At 22:10, Israeli forces raided Azzoun town.
- **Detentions:** Mohammed Nazal from Kufar Lagef was detained

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 12:40, a group of settlers gathered at the entrance of Azzoun town until Israeli forces removed them.
- (ii) At 22:40, Israeli settlers stoned several vehicles near Jett village...

Wall Gates

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras 'Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction stopped in Kafr Laqef village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Al-Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open between 07:00 and 02:00 only to residents of the neighbourhood.
- (ii) At 'Awarta commercial checkpoint, civilians are only allowed to cross between 05:00 and 20:00, and between 05:00 and 15:00 on Fridays. All vehicles can access the city of Nablus, but only commercial vehicles and ambulances can leave the city through the checkpoint.
- (iii) At 02:30, Israeli forces restricted their procedures at Hwara checkpoints.

- (i) At 09:50, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance of Jamean town, searching people and cars..
- (ii) At 10:35, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint between Burin and Tel villages, searching civilians and vehicles.

- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israeli army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 *dunums* of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.
- <u>Closure of Main Roads</u>: The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages.
- <u>Military checkpoints</u>: At 10:40, Israeli forces restricted the procedures on (Container checkpoint) and abstracted traffic, and held 8 buses with international women from the solidarity movement who had participated in demonstrations in Qalandia checkpoint.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 17:15 21:00, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint at Al-Nashaah junction, searching civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Taqou town, searching people and cars.

• Raids:

- (i) At 22:35, Israeli forces raided Um Rukba in Al-Khader town.
- (ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Urtas village.
- <u>Detentions:</u> At 02:00, Israeli forces detained Swfat Al-Tura at the Container checkpoint.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:20, a group of Israeli settlers stoned cars near Joura Al-Shamaa, causing damages to a car owned by Bassam Jaber.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction stopped northwest of Beit Jala town.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Dhahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village.
- (v) At 12:40, on September 13th 2011,the Israeli army closed the bypass road leading to agricultural land near road #35& 60 North of Hebron with dirt mounds.

- (i) At 16:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fawar intersection, searching people and cars.
- (ii) At 19:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Samou intersection, searching people and cars.

- (ii) At 21:45, Israeli forces raided area near Beit Khahel village.
- (iii) At 00:35 01:30, Israeli forces raided Sair town.

- (v) At 03:50 05:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriah town.
- (vi) At 04:55, Israeli forces raided the town of Halhoul.
- **Physical Assaults**: At 20:14, Israeli forces near Halhoul checkpoint, physicaly assaulted Ahmad Nasser (16 years);he was admitted to hospital.
- <u>Demonstrations:</u> At 13:00, Palestinian and international peace activists marched towards agricultural land located near "Kermi Tsor" settlement, protesting against settler violence and demanding access of farmers to their land; confrontations ensued after soldiers prevented the demonstrators them from reaching the protest site. Anas Masuda was treated for teargas inhalation and Hamza Abu Mazya (17 years) was physically assaulted.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction stopped in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.
