#### WEST BANK

#### Closure:

- On September 17<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at (i) checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 45 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

#### **Closure of Main Roads:**

- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

#### **Checkpoints:**

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Temporary Detention:** At 16:00, Israeli forces temporarily detained 2 residents: Fadi Sajdiya and Hamza Zahran as they stormed a car was near the entrance of Oalandiya and released them at 19:00.
- **Assault on Property:** On September 17<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces stormed Al-Qarami neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem and served eviction orders for 28 homes for alleged critical rehabilitation repairs for the homes and gave its residents 30 days to leave their homes for alleged construction work and also fined each family a financial penalty of 3500 NIS approximately 1000 USD for each day they do not leave their homes.

#### At 21:00 on November 21<sup>st</sup> 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November **ALL** 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21<sup>st</sup> 2013 **DISTRICTS** re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza and as a result injured a Palestinian Gunman. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad **NORTHERN** through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
