JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Eizariya. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, clashed with several residents and detained a resident. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Qutna village, clashed with several residents and as a result injured Ibrahim Al-Fuqiya leaving him hospitalised with contusions then withdrew at 21:40. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On September 16th 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Shadi Ghazawneh and Mahmoud Shoubaki during their raid into Al-Ram as mentioned in the previous report. (ii) At dawn on September 17th 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Rami Al-Joulani and Rami Barakat in Jerusalem. (iii) Israeli forces detained Atta Erekat in Abu Dis.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 11:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers as well as broke off several Olive tree limbs, which are planted around Al-Aqsa mosque. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Surda village junction until 12:00. (ii) At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atarah bridge located in North Bir Zeit until 21:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 07:30 on September 17th 2014, Israeli forces raided Deir Ammar village until 08:10. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:40, Israeli settlers positioned near Deir Ammar village stoned several labourers as they were working at a nearby stone cutting mill.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:10, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 21:30. (ii) At 05:20, Israeli forces raided Faqou’a village, stormed a home then withdrew at 06:00. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near Imrih village temporarily detained Ali Khalil (A resident of Anin village) then released him at 04:00. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 18:10, Israeli forces positioned near “Movo Dotan” settlement stoned several residents and vehicles passing along the main road connecting Jenin and Tulkarem.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces positioned near Atuf village temporarily detained several farmers including four Women and seized a tractor then released them later. (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at Tayassir checkpoint temporarily detained Jihad Wahdan (A resident Tayassir village) then released him at 14:00. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> On September 17th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Al-Malah area in the North Jordan valley and served a halt to construction order for a livestock barracks owned by Mohammad Al-Faqir.

<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 12:15 and again at 19:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 05:30 on September 17th 2014, Israeli forces raided Aqaba village, summoned Moath Amarnah to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning after storming his home and confiscating a hunting rifle.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 13:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwarah checkpoint, temporarily detained Iz-Al-Dain Shamasah (A resident of Beita) then released him later and then again intensified their restrictions at 21:00 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:30. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 09:40. (ii) At 18:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Burin village until 20:40.

(ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Talfit village, stormed three homes then withdrew at 04:20. • <u>Detention:</u> At 04:00 on September 17th 2014, Israeli forces detained Musa Idris (A residents of Askar Camp in Nablus) during their raid into Nablus as mentioned in the previous report. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over and injured the child: Musa'ab Al-Hilu (14 years old) along the main road in Huwara and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions. (ii) At 19:05, Israeli settlers stormed the east area of Burin village and stoned several residents and Sheppard's as they were herding their sheep in the area.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.

(ii) At 01:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Nabi Musa area (along the main road connecting Jericho and Jerusalem). • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 13:10, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge temporarily detained Ahmad Abu Al-Rub (A Palestinian Police Officer) then released him at 14:00.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.

(iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Taqou’ until 17:40. (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village (located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur) until 21:25. (iii) At 19:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahur until 21:30. (iv) At 22:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Taqou’ until 23:20. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Nihalin village, detained three residents then withdrew at 03:10. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:50 on September 17th 2014, Israeli forces detained two residents: Billal Atad and Khaled Faraj during their raid into Al-Duhisheh camp as mentioned in the previous report. (ii) At 20:45, Israeli forces positioned at Container checkpoint detained Mu’taz Al-Ramahi (A resident of Al-Jalazoun camp in Ramallah). (iii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Issam Ghathiya, Maher Al-Malat and Muhanad Shaqarneh in Nahalin village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:10, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou’ fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City.

(ii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Yatta, stormed four homes, temporarily detained its residents then released them after being questioned by Intelligence officers. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Raed Abu Wardah in Al-Urub camp. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:50, Israeli forces temporarily detained three children: Mahmoud Mut'ab (12 years old), Ahmad Mut'ab (10 years old) and Yazan Abu Halaweh (11 years old) in Abu Sneienh neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On September 16th 2014, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over a heard of sheep along Aqwawis village in east Yatta and as a result, killed eight heads of livestock (sheep) owned by Taleb Nu'man and Ibrahim Nu'man.
