WEST BANK

• Closure:

- Since September 17th 2013, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 45 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

• Raid: At 10:25, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, clashed with its residents, served a demolition order to demolish a home owned Mu'taz Badr for allegedly being built without a licence and that it is located 25 m away from the Wall thus giving the owner 7 days to implement the demolition of his home or Israeli forces will demolish the home and fine him for the demolition cost.

• Assault on Places of Worship: At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police officers stormed Al-Israeli Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem during which Israeli police closed the main entrance to the mosque and banned several school children from entering the mosque then reopened it at a later time.

Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) At 09:35 on September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north entrance to Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.

	 Attack: At 18:25, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazun camp fired coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
	 Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
	Closure of Main Road:

- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 11:30 on June 8th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 13:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Shuwarat village until 14:30.

• Raid:

- (i) At 16:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr, set up a checkpoint then withdrew at 17:50.
- (ii) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Taqou', fired flash grenades into the sky as they stormed several homes then withdrew at 02:00.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction has continued in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Hebron.
- (ii) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Khursa village junction.

HEBRON

- (iii)At 13:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge.
- (iv)At 13:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Farsh Al-Hawa located in north Hebron.
- (v) At 13:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Wadi Qabbun junction located in north Hebron.
- (vi)At 15:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp.

• Raid:

- (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron.
- (ii) At dawn on September 19th 2013, Israeli forces raided Al-Haddadiya area located in east Yatta, stormed and searched 2 homes and detained 2 residents.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Yasser Au Sabaha and Murad Abu Eliyan in east Yatta.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning and temporarily detained the child Ibrahim Al-luwali (12 years old); a resident of Al-Fuwar camp then released him at a later time.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained the child Ma'moun Abu Falah 915 years old) and released him at a later time.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS

- At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.
- On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Gaza and Central Gaza.
- Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire and launching projectiles toward the Green Line.

NORTHERN GAZA

• <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
