	• <u>Closure</u> : (i) On September 16 th 2011the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying	

checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City and prevented civilians from other Palestinian districts from entering the city to perform Friday prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque Compound. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in (ii) the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating (ii) the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (iii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through **JERUSALEM** Qalandiya checkpoint. Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem Raids: At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Samir Amis neighbourhood north of Jerusalem Attacks: At 18:30, Israeli forces fired teargas grenades towards civilians as they passed through the Qalandiya checkpoint. **Wall Gates:** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu (i) Dis town. The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on (ii) Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

- (iii) At 01:30, a group of Israeli settlers raided Kifel Harres village and stoned homes near the village before withdrawing following the intervention of Israeli forces.
- <u>Demonstrations:</u> At 10:30 Families of detainees rallies in front of the International Red Cross office in Salfit in support of Palestinian detainees and the President's decision to apply for membership at the United Nations.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction has resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement Emmanuel.
- <u>Closure of Main Road</u>: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Ouja village with cement blocks.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area. - (ii) At 21:45, Israeli forces set up a flying checkpoint near Ein Dweik village, located at the northern entrance of Jericho and impeded the free flow of traffic.

GAZA STRIP

At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 10 August 2011 at 21:00. Ceasefire Violation: Israeli forces violated the ceasefire agreement by, raiding and openening fire in Gaza. Ceasefire Violation: Palestinian gunmen violated the ceasefire agreement by launching projectiles towards the Green Line.
