• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers in Al-Aqsa mosque compound because of the Jewish New Year.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

• Raid:

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Hizma village, demolished 6 Baracks and a merchant shop owned by: Samer Al-Souri (2 Baracks), Ghalib Salah Al-Din (3 Barracks and a furniture shop) and Muarda Hamad (A barracks used as a tile selling shop) for allegedly being built without a licence and Israeli forces also served military orders for the demolition of 2 Greenhouses owned by Ibrahim Salem and Mohammad Sabah then withdrew at 11:30.
- (ii) At dawn on September 21st 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and detained eight residents.
- (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Bir Nabala until 19:20.
- (iv) At 03:15, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis until 05:55.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 12:30 and again at 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at the North entrance of Al-Ram fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several resident alleged stoning.

• Detention:

(i) At dawn on September 21st 2015, Israeli forces detained 11 residents: Mohammad Abu Najma, Amir Abu Najma, Sharif Abu Maliya, Hamza Al-Sewari, Bashar Abu Rajab, Ismail Ramouz, Mohammad Al-Shahbour, Mohammad Abu Jum'a, Ahmad Ashir, Salman Abu Sbatien and Mohammad Abu Al-Hawa in Al-Tur and Ras Al-Amoud

(ii) Israeli forces detained eight residents: Nadim Al-Safadi, Fadi Atiya, Mahmoud Darbas, Ahmad Darbas, Jamil Shartouq, Mahmoud Muhsien, Jamil Muhsien and Sufiyan Mahmoud in Al-Eisawiya. • Temporary Detention: At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Qatanin gate (A main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem temporally detained Jihad Al-Ghazawi then released him at a later time. • Home Demolition: On the morning of September 21st 2015, Israeli forces stormed Silwan neighbourhood and demolished a home (under construction) owned by A; l-Abbassi family for allegedly being built without a licence during which they clashed with several residents were protesting the demolition. • Assault on Places of Worship: At 08:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.

Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Agraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Oabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. Flying Checkpoint: (i) At 08:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Yitsahar" settlement junction located in North Huwara until 11:00. (ii) At 09:40, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Dajjan village until 11:00. (iii) At 10:00, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 11:00. - (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 12:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Husan village, temporarily detained Abdallah Ghathioya (A resident of Nihalin village) and then released him at 14:10.

• Attack:

- (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned near Dar Salah Village Bridge located at the east entrance of Beit Sahour fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 17:25, Israeli forces positioned near the West entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 17:40, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At dawn on September 21st 2015, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning which allegedly injured an Israeli soldier.
- <u>Home Occupation:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces stormed Taqou' and occupied Yusef Al-Sha'ers home and converted its rooftop into a military post then withdrew at 19:45
- **Demonstration:** At 12:50, a demonstration took place in Bi'r Onah area located in Beit Jallah protesting against the levelling of agricultural land for the purpose of wall construction during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents and prevented them from reaching the demonstration site.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to closed Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to

- Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Haloul Bridge.
- **Raid:** At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Ourub camp and detained four residents including a child.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained four residents: Baha Al-Khamour (17 years old), Ahmad AL-Khamour, Imad Al-Jindi and Abdel-Rahman Jawabrah in Al-Oroub camp.

• Temporary Detention:

- (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces temporarily detained the child Issam Abu Omar (13 years old) in the old city of Hebron then released him at a later time.
- (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Oroub camp temporarily detained Muhanad Abu Khiran (A National Security Force officer) then released him later.

• Attack:

- (i) At 08:50, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Einoun village junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several school children for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 13:35, Israeli forces positioned near Safa village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and stormed Khalil Abu Daya's home and assaulted Nabila Abu Daya and sprayed pepper spray onto her face and onto her sister Jamila Abu Daya face leaving them hospitalised.
- Assault on Places of Worship: On the evening of September 20th 2015, a group of Israeli settlers held a concert in Al-Ibrahimi mosque compound in the old city of Hebron after Israeli forces imposed restrictions on Palestinians in the surrounding area of the mosque compound.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 19:30, an Israeli settler driving his vehicle near Al-Ibrahimi mosque compound in the old city of Hebron ran over the child: Mahdi Idris (7 years old) leaving him hospitalised with a broken neck.

- At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Khan Yunis.

	 Palestinian gunmen broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire and launching projectiles towards the Green Line.
NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. Palestinian Attack: At 02:30, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.
GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decisions.
CENTRAL GAZA	 Attack: At 10:45 on September 13th 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural lane in east Al-Maghazi camp. Detention: At 11:00, Israeli forces detained an unidentified resident near Al-Buriej camp as he was attempting to climb the border fence into Israel.
Khan Younis	<u>Attack:</u> At 20:25, Israeli Naval forces opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats on the shores of the city Kanyounis.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed. Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
