JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Anan village and summoned Yussef Jumhour to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Attack:</u> At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned near the North junction of Al-Ram fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces using Military bulldozers demolished 20 Tomb stones in the Islamic cemetery located near Al-Absat gate (One of the main entrance gates leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 10:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Forces and Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked Worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

	<p>the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.</p> <p>(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Beit Liqya and Khirbathat Al-Misbah until 22:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Turmusaya, stormed a merchant store, inspected surveillance camera footage then withdrew at 16:20. (ii) At 09:40, Israeli forces raided Awarta and stormed a home. (iii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, stormed two homes then withdrew at 04:15. (iv) At 04:10, Israeli forces raided Ramallah, stormed two homes (one of which is under construction) then withdrew at 06:30. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 14:15, Israeli forces temporarily detained four children: Imad Ayad (10 years old), Mohammad Rizq Hamad, Mohammad Faraj Hamad and Suleiman Odeh (11 years old) near the bypass road near Silwad then released them at 16:20.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Bruqin village until 10:30. (ii) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Zababdah, detained a resident and temporarily detained Taha Al-Sharqawi and released him later then withdrew at 04:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mahdi Al-Sharqawi in Al-Zababda.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Tubas and Aqaba, clashed with several residents and as a result, suffocated Mohammad Abu Muhsien from tear gas inhalation then withdrew at 02:45. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Farisiya village located in the North Jordan valley temporarily seized a herd of goats owned by : Mahmoud Ka'abneh, and Suliman Ka'abneh for allegedly entering a closed Military area and also temporarily detained the child Iz-Al-Din Ka'abneh (16 years old) and released him at a later time.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near "Aveni Hivits". • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Bazariya village junction located in east Anabta until 19:00.

<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<p>of Azzun town.</p> <p>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</p> <p>(iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya, temporarily detained Billal Majd (A resident of Al-Nabi Eliyas) and released him later then withdrew at 21:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:55, Israeli forces raided Habalah. (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Ras Atiya village. (iii) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Azzun, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 01:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Shave Shomron” settlement junction, temporarily detained five residents: Yazan Anabtawi, Nour-Al-Din Abdul-Haq, Sameh Antar, Abdallah Ayoub and Mohammad Mataw’e then released them later. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Assirah Al-Qibliyah village until 20:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:30. (ii) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Burin, stormed several homes, detained four residents then withdrew at 05:30. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Salim Malitat in Beit Furiq. (ii) Israeli forces detained four residents: Omar Qaddus, Mohammad Najjar, Mahmoud Assous and Abed Najjar in Burin village. • <u>Land Levelling:</u> At 15:15, Israeli forces stormed Al-Saba’ area in east Burin village and levelled a plot of agricultural land owned by Ghalib Al-Khatib.

<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Zawiya until 18:20.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction, detained a Civil Defence officer and again at 21:20 temporarily detained Saeb Kuhayl (a resident of Jenin) and released him later then withdrew at 21:25. (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 19:10. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Jericho and Aqbat Al-Jabr camp, attempted to enter the Palestinian Authority border crossing with Jordan by were prevented by Palestinian Police then withdrew at 12:40. (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village. (iii) At 20:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Jiftlik village, detained a resident then withdrew at 22:40. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Tariq Abu Amr near the Dead Sea junction. (ii) Israeli forces detained Abdel-Jabbar Bashirat in Al-Jiftlik.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at checkpoint near Dar Salah village (located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur) until 09:30. (ii) At 10:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Khadr until 11:45. (iii) At 14:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the West entrance of Taqou' until 15:25. • <u>Raid:</u> At 20:45, Israeli forces raided Harmalah and fired flash grenades into the skies. • <u>Attack:</u> At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Aydah camp in Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-' Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) On September 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiw Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and Al-Ras area in Ithna located near the wall gate. (vii) At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron.

(ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'im, detained a child then withdrew at 02:05. (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir, stormed several homes and detained six residents including two University students. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces detained two residents including a child: Midhat Al-Titi (16 years old) and Ibrahim Basali (both residents of Al-Urub camp) as they were reporting to Israeli intelligence based on a prior summon. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mo'ayad Tarirat (17 years old) in Bani Na'im. (iii) Israeli forces detained six residents: Izat Shalaadah, Jihad Shaladah, Ahmad Shiladeh, Islam Qawazabi, Mahmoud Shalaadah and Arif Shalaadah in Sa'ir.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents , students , tourists and businessmen (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
