WEST BANK

Closure:

- On the evening of September 21st 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their (i) restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers in Al-Aqsa mosque compound because of the Jewish New Year.
- The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in (ii) the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

Closure of Main Roads:

- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village.
- The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (ii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 21:30, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints along Salah Al-Din road in Beit Hanina

Raid:

- (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Kafr Agab village.
- (ii) At 16:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram and stormed a home.
- (iii) At 00:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and Abu Dis until 05:00.

Attack:

- (i) At 12:30 and again at 21:10, Israeli forces positioned at the North entrance of Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several resident alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 21:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several resident alleged stoning.
- Physical Assault: At 09:30, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Qatanin (A Main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem assaulted Salah Al-Zaghari.
- Expulsion: At 21:00, Israeli authorities ordered the expulsion of Mohammad Al-Za'tari from Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period of 30 days.
- **Destruction of Property:** At 13:00, Israeli forces stormed Al-Eisawiya village and demolished a barracks owned by Saed Obied.

JERUSALEM

- Assault on Places of Worship: At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 16:50, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Silwan and assaulted two residents: during which Israeli forces detained the two residents who attempted to prevent the settler attack and assaulted Dalal Hadad leaving her hospitalised with a fractured arm.

• Detention:

- (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces detained Ragheb Abu Sineneh in the old city of Jerusalem.
- (ii) At 13:50, Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Abu Khdeir in Shu'fat neighbourhood.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Oday Hadad and Basel Al-Hadad in Silwan neighbourhood.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) At 11:10 on September 19th b2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance to Deir Nathim village with Cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 11:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Turmus'aya until 12:40.
- (ii) At 14:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp until 16:50.
- (iii) At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Nathim village until 17:30.
- (iv) At 17:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Halamish" settlement.
- (v) At 19:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Al-Mughier village until 00:30.
- (vi) At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Atarah bridge located in North Bir Ziet.
- (vii)At 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Beit Ur Al-Tahta and and Beit Ur Al-Foqa villages until 00:35.
- (viii) At 21:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village until 00:30.
- (ix) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Ofra" settlement, temporarily detained Al-Qaman Hamayel (A National Security Force officer) then released him at 00:20.

• Raid:

- (i) At 03:15, Israeli forces raided Beit Rima, detained a resident and summoned three residents: Ismail Al-Rimawi, Adli Al-Rimawi and Abdel-Salam Al-Rimawi to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (ii) At 09:20, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 11:50.
- (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ur Al-Foqa, stormed a home then withdrew at 03:30.

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH

	Detention: Israeli forces detained Safwat Al-Rimawi in Beit Rima.
	Attack: (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces positioned near "Pesagout" settlement located in east Al-Bireh city fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 11:25, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of "Ofar" military base fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
JENIN	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. Raid: At 18:15, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad until 18:45. Temporary Detention: At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned at (Rihan-Barta'a) checkpoint temporarily detained Mohammad Qubha (A resident of Turat Al-Sharqiya village) then released him later. Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TULKAREM	 Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. Raid: At 07:00 on September 21st 2015, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Ghouson until 10:00. At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Zieta and informed the local village council to prevent children from throwing stones towards Israeli Militarily posts in the area.
QALQILIYA	Closure of Roads: (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
	 Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.

NABLUS	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.
	 Military checkpoints: At 00:55, Israeli forces closed Huwara checkpoint and prevented residents and vehicles from passing through the checkpoint for alleged firebombing of an Israeli settler vehicle near "Yitsahar" settlement junction located in North Huwara then reopened it at 01:20. Flying Checkpoint: At 17:00, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq. At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Dajjan village.
	 Raid: At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Nablus, clashed with several residents as they stormed a building and as a result injured two residents: Mohammad Basalat and Mohammad Hussein as well as leaving Nur Al-Din Sharida suffocating from tear gas inhalation, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:00. Detention: Israeli forces detained Mufid Ghazal in Nablus. Temporary Detention: At 14:50, Israeli forces temporarily detained two children: Karam Nassar (15 years old) and Khatib Ziyadeh (14 years old) along the main bypass road in Madma village then released them at 17:40.
SALFIT	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. Checkpoints: At 00:25, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic until 01:20. Flying Checkpoint: At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Salfit. Raid: At 10:55, Israeli forces raided Bidya until 14:30. At 15:40, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Dik until 16:55. At 23:35, Israeli forces raided Qarwat Bani Hassan. At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Zawiya, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 03:20. Temporary Detention: At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara junction temporarily detained Aws Thabet then released him after confiscating his vehicle at 11:40. At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint junction temporarily detained Ahmad Suliman (A resident of Marda village) then released him at 14:20.
JERICHO	 Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. Flying Checkpoint: At 19:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho. Settler Violence: At 22:00, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over 40 Goats owned by Ayash Da'ajneh (A resident of Fasayil village) near "Malee Ofrim" settlement.
BETHLEHEM	Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the

- exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 13:00 and again at 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Jallah.
- (ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Khader.
- **Raid:** At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Tagou' and searched four homes.

• Attack:

- (i) At 11:10, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Nour Al-Khatib.
- (ii) At 11:10, Israeli forces positioned near the North entrance of Taqou' fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and occupied Saleem Sulimans home and converted its rooftop into a military post then withdrew at 12:05.
- (iii) At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned near Husan village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned near Dar Salah Village Bridge located at the east entrance of Beit Sahour fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (v) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at the West entrance of Tagou' fired

stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to closed Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

• Raid:

- (i) At 08:25, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, detained resident and summoned Zuhier Muqbil to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (ii) At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Burj village, stormed several homes and detained a woman.
- (iii)At 23:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Tarma village and occupied several homes and converted their rooftops into military posts during which they clashed with several residents and left the residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation then withdrew at 03:20.

■ Attack

- (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Zawiya and Tal'at Abu Hadid area's in the old city of Hebron, near Halhoul area junction, Halhoul bridge and at the entrance of Bani Na'im fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents who were protesting against the continued Israeli attack on Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and as a result injured the child Hamza Abu Ayash (17 years old) near Bab Al-Zawiya area and detained a resident near Al-Huwar area junction.
- (ii) At 19:10, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Duwar area in Sa'ir fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 07:30 on September 22nd 2015, Israeli forces positioned near a checkpoint located along Al-Shuhada road in the old city of Hebron and opened fire towards an unidentified woman leaving her critically injured for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier.

• Detention:

- (i) At 21:30, Israeli forces detained three children: Nizar Salhab (15 years old), Tarik Salhab (16 years old) and Awni Abu Shamsiya (16 years old) in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Khalil Sabarneh (17 years old) in Beit Ummar.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Abeer Masharqa in Al-Burj village.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Hanihin (A resident of Halhoul) in Al-

HEBRON

Huwar area located in North Halhoul.

• <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 11:40, Israeli settlers stormed the old city of Hebron and assaulted the child Mohammad Abu Shamasneh (13 years old) and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions.

GAZA STRIP

At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the **ALL** fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by **DISTRICTS** the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by raiding and opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and Gaza. **Closure of Crossing Point:** Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling **NORTHERN** abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. **GAZA** Raid: At 09:00, Israeli forces escorting several Military Bulldozers stormed 100m

east the city of Jabaleh, and levelled a plot of land near the border fence then withdrew at 10:30. **Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January **GAZA** 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decisions. Raid: At 11:00, Israeli forces escorting several Military Bulldozers stormed 200m into the vicinity of Jaher Al-Dik and levelled a plot of land near the border fence then withdrew at 14:45. **Closure of Crossing Points:** (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. **RAFAH** (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
