All Districts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> At 12:00 on September 22nd 2015, Israeli Military imposed a full closure on the West Bank for the Jewish Holiday and prevented residents including those holding Entry permits from entering Jerusalem and Israel with the exception of Diplomatic missions and International Organization employees until 24:00 on September 23rd 2015.
JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00 on September 22nd 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers in Al-Aqsa mosque compound because of the Jewish New Year. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several resident alleged stoning. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned at Shu’fat checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several resident alleged stoning. <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:30, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 17:30, Israeli settlers positioned near “Jivat Za’iv” settlement stoned residents and vehicles passing along the main road near the settlement. <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:50 on September 21st 2015, Israeli forces detained two residents: Mohammad Abu Al-Hawa and Ibrahim Abu Al-Hawa in Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (ii) At 00:15 on September 22nd 2015, Israeli forces detained five residents including a child and a Man and his wife: Yusef Shihadeh (16 years old),

	<p>Wafa Al-Ajlouni, Moqafaq Al-Ajlouni, Mohammad Al-Ajlouni and Fida Al-Ajlouni during their raid into Al-Eizariya.</p> <p>(iii) At 08:00, Israeli forces detained Jawad Al-Oboeda (A resident of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem).</p> <p>(iv) At 08:00 on September 22nd 2015, Israeli forces detained Ribhi Al-Qaraq (A resident of Al-Eizariya).</p> <p>(v) At 09:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Aqsa mosque compound detained two residents: Firas Al-Dibis (A mosque guard and resident of Al-Tur neighbourhood) and Mohammad Abu Diyab (A resident of Bab Al-Salaslal area in the old city of Jerusalem).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. (ii) At 11:10 on September 19th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance to Deir Nathim village with Cement blocks. • Flying Checkpoint: At 14:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ur Al-Foqa until 17:00. • Raid: At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Safa village until 20:10.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 10:40 and again at 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Lid until 21:20. • Wall Gates: At 12:30, Israeli forces closed the main wall gate in Far'oun village and prevented several farmers from reaching their agricultural land located behind the wall gate until 13:15.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • Raid: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Jayyous, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 22:30. (ii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Azzun, stormed a home then withdrew at

	<p>04:00.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Raid: At 02:50 on September 21st 2015, Israeli forces raided Qabalan and temporarily detained Ahmad Az’ar then released him later. • Detention: At 02:10 on September 22nd 2015, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abdou during their raid into Nablus (As mentioned in the previous report).
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic. • Temporary Detention: At 10:25, Israeli forces positioned at Za’tara checkpoint temporarily detained five residents: Rashid Ishtayeh, Abdel Khaliq Ishtayeh, Khaled Abu Kishiq, Hisham Ishtayeh and Hatem Ishtawi then released them at 10:35.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Physical Assault: At 08:50, Abdel Fatah Mizhir (A resident of Balata camp) was hospitalised in Jericho after Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge assaulted him.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads:

	<p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.</p> <p>(iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.</p> <p>(iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.</p> <p>(v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Taqou', temporarily detained Saleem Mifrih (A Preventive Security Force officer) then released him later. (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Husan village, temporarily detained four residents: Ahmad Hamarah, Fayeq Hamara, Abdel-Shaqer Hamara and Sabri Hamara then released then at a later time and withdrew at 14:30. (iii) At 12:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Beit Fajjar until 13:40. (iv) At 15:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Harmalah village until 16:30. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:40 on September 21st 2015, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Jallah detained two residents: Mohammad Bouja and Omar Shouqat after confiscating their vehicle for allegedly having a knife in their possession. (ii) At 12:40 on September 21st 2015, Israeli forces detained Hassan Shuqat (A resident of Bethlehem) as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning in "Kafar Itsiyon" settlement v based on a prior summon. (iii) On the evening of September 21st 2015, Israeli forces detained three residents: Abbas Rashaydeh, Salameh Rashaydeh and Hussein Rashaydeh (All residents of Arab Al-Rashaydeh village).

Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.</p> <p>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.</p> <p>(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.</p> <p>(v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Ourb camp and temporarily detained Malik Al-Sharif (A National Security Force officer) then released him at 15:45. • <u>Killing:</u> At 08:00, Hadeel Al-Shalhamoun (A resident of Hebron) Died of Injuries sustained after Israeli forces opened fire towards her near a checkpoint located in the old city of Hebron as mentioned in the previous report. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Zawiya area located in Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
