The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in (ii) the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.

- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

- (iii) Israeli forced detained Adham Abu Ayash in Abu Dis.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Ahmad Nassr, Usayed Al-Rjoub, Saber Najjar and Faysal Al-Sabar in Al-Eizariya.
- **Physical Assault:** At 21:10, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Mukabbir neighbourhood in Jerusalem assaulted Suhayeb Au Jamal leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) At 09:35, on September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.
- (iii) At 24:00, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gate leading to "Bet El" Settlement which leads to Al-Jalazun camp main road.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 18:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Turmus'ayya until 19:40.

• Raid:

- (i) At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh temporarily detained residents and released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers then withdrew at 11:30.
- (ii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Aboud, stormed several homes and detained 4 residents.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Mohammad Shalawneh, Rami Al-Barghouthi, Daoud Abu Hussein and Suleiman Abu Hussein in Aboud.

Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

• Wall Construction:

(i) Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shamron settlement.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.
- <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 11:20 and again at 20:10, Israeli forces increased their restrictions at Huwwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 20:50.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at "Shave Shamron" settlement junction until 10:00.
- (ii) At 19:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Sharaf and detained a resident.

• Detention:

- (i) At 03:50, Israeli forces detained Khalil Al-Jilani in Nablus.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Khalil Raba'a at Deir Sharaf village junction.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 11:20, Israeli forces positioned at Huwwara junction temporally detained 2 Security officers: Rama Shabrawi (Police Officer) and Alaa Sanakra (National Security Officer).

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli settlers stormed the area between Aqraba and Yanun village levelled 20 dunumes of agricultural land owned by Abu Shalhab and Rajabi families in an attempt to seize the plot of land.
- (ii) At 14:20, Israeli settlers set fire to agricultural land in Tel and Sara village and as a result destroyed 180 olive trees owned by Suleiman Hamad, Amr Samara and Mohammad Faris before Palestinian Civil defence officers were able to put out the flames.
- (iii) At 24:00, Israeli settlers stormed Huwwara and sprayed pepper spray into

- (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area
- (iii) Since 17:40 on September 22nd 2013, Israeli forces closed checkpoints and steel gates leading into the old city of Hebron, installed several checkpoints around the city, stormed and searched several homes after an Israeli soldier was shot and killed by an unidentified individual and as a result left 3 schools closed.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

(vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

- (vii)At 22:40, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading to Sa'ir village with Cement blocks.
- (viii) At 09:45, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) Since 19:00 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces set up 9 checkpoints at the north entrance of Hebron, the entrance of Farsh Al-Hawa area, the entrance of Beit Kahil and the entrance of Nabi Na'im, at Beit Anun junction, in the area located between Hebron and Dura, at the entrance leading to South Hebron and the area between Yatta and Al-Samou'.
- (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up checkpoints at the north entrance of Hebron

• Raid:

- (i) At 03:000 on September 22nd 2013, Israeli forces raided Surif and detained 2 residents.

- (iii)At 04:00 on September 22nd 2013, Israeli forces raided Dura and detained a resident
- <u>Attack:</u> At 16:10, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Zawiya fired rubber coated steel bullets, tear and stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 16 residents including 9 children: Sanad Idris (10 years old), Wassim Qa'ud (10 years old), Kamal Al-Qawasmi (14 years old), Mohammad Al-Hurub (16 years old), Samer Al-Qawasmi (17 years old), Firas Al-Hamouni (16 years old), Mu'tasim Mafalsa (16 years old), Ahmad Amar (16 years old), Ibrahim Abu Hata (16 years old), Othman Salhab, Mahmoud Abu Assiba, Mohammad Abu Siniya, Abdel Halim Zamar'a, Muhanad Al-Hiroun, Imad Abu Khalaf and Samer Burish.

• Detention:

- (i) At 03:00 on September 22nd 2013, Israeli forces detained the child Oday Khalil (17 years old) as they stormed his home in Beit Ummar.
- (ii) At dawn on September 24th 2013, Israeli forces detained Kamal Shahin in the old city of Hebron.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:20, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Yacoub Shab'han (National Security officer) then released him at 18:40.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 17:50, Israeli settlers stormed the old city of Hebron and stoned several residents and homes.
- (ii) At 18:15, Israeli settlers assaulted and injured the child Awni Abu Shamsiya (12 years old) and smashed a camera belonging to Manal Da'na and Imad Abu Shamsiya (Both Journalist) in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron.
- (iii)On the evening of September 23rd 2013, Israeli settlers stormed the old city of Hebron, stormed a home owned by Abu Rajab family in an attempt to confiscate it.
- <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> On September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed access to the Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron in order to allow Israeli settler to perform Talmudic rituals in the mosque.
- <u>Demonstration</u>: At 11:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Rd Cross headquarters in Hebron in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their released from Israeli prisons.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction was halted in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town for Jewish holiday.
