JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 13:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north junction of Al-Ram until 14:15.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 19:15 on September 24th 2014, Israeli forces detained five residents including a Woman: Samiha Judeh, Luai Hadib, Obaydah Otwan, Hikmat Tufah and Majdi Ibrahim in Sur Bahar village.
 - (ii) At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem detained three residents: Amir Al-Khatib (Director of Al-Aqsa association for archaeology), Mohammad Obeid (A resident of Al-Eisawiya) and Ayman Thiyab.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 09:35, Israeli forces positioned at Hata gate in the old city of Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 21:40, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Anata fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Assault on Education Sector:** At 10:30, Israeli forces stormed The Islamic Orphanage Association and School in Jerusalem, fired stun and tear gas grenades and also assaulted several students leaving them hospitalised with contusions.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:**
 - (i) At 10:00, Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas

	<p>grenades towards several residents and as a result injured two residents and left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</p> <p>(ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gates leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound and allowed the Israeli Minister of Interior and several Israeli settlers to storm the compound.</p> <p>(iii) At 21:30, 3 Israeli settlers stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 10:00, Israeli settlers assaulted the child Mohammad Al-Zaghal (11 year old) during which local residents were able to aid the child and prevented further assault during which Israeli police temporarily detained the child. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 23:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atarah bridge until 24:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 17:15, Israeli forces raided Turmusaya and patrolled the area then set up a checkpoint to allegedly search for a missing Israeli settler.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 23:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jenin until 00:50. • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:20, Israeli forces raided Zubaba village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 19:10. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 23:55, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed the area of the previously abandoned settlement of “Homish” and fired fireworks then withdrew later.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Allar, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.

QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun until 16:45. (ii) At 23:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Jit village. • <u>Raid:</u> At 15:00 and again at 21:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Eliyas village until 21:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 22:05, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwarah checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:15 and again at 20:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq, temporarily detained Nathir Hanini and released him later then until 22:30. (ii) At 17:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Aqraba. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:25, Israeli forces raided Qabalan until 22:30. • <u>Attack:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Salem village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.

	<p>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: At 16:15, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic until 16:45.

(ii) At 19:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near road (90) junction near Al-Oja village until 21:35.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • Flying Checkpoint: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Za'tara until 10:45. 	<p>(i) At 13:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 14:50.</p> <p>(ii) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, detained a resident after storming his home then withdrew at 05:00.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Foad Jalaghif in Bethlehem. • <u>Attack:</u> At 11:15 and again at 16:30, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</p> <p>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • <u>Attack:</u> On the morning of September 25th 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach in West Beit Lahiya.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.

(iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
