

(vi) On September 4<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed a road in Eiwn Al-Bas and Al-Bayda and

Al-Ras area in Ithna located near the wall gate.

(vii)At 13:40 on September 16<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron.

#### **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 11:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge until 12:30.
- (ii) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Farsh Al-Hawa area located in north Hebron and detained a resident.
- (iii)At 18:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Fuwar camp until 19:15.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint at the entrance of Farsh Al-Hawa area located in north Hebron detained Oday Al-Masri (A resident of Ithna).
- **Temporary Detention:** At 22:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained two children: Loai Al-Asali (13 years old) and Mohammad Al-Hashlamoun (13 years old) then released him at 24:00.
- Attack: At 19:15, Israeli forces positioned near Khursa village junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 08:00, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gates leading to Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron in order to allow Israeli settler to perform Talmudic rituals.

GAZA

- At 19:00 on August 26<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza and as a result injured four workers.

# **NORTHERN**

Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients.

#### Attack:

- (i) At 07:50 on September 19th 2014, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several labours as they were attempting to climb the border fence near Burat Abu Samara area in North Beit Lahiya and as a result injured two residents: Atta Al-Hassumi and Ahmad Al-Sus.
- (ii) At 11:30 on September 20th 2014, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several labourers as they were attempting

	to climb the border fence near Um Al-Nasser village in North Beit Lahiya
	and as a result injured two residents: Khaled Abu Sata and Jibril Qa'uad.
GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points:     (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.     (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
