JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On September 26th 2014, The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Detention:</u> On September 25th 2014, Israeli forces detained four residents: Yazid Ibrahim, Iz Al-Rashq, Adnana Al-Rashq and Daoud Al-Rashq. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 19:45, Israeli forces positioned near Ras Al-Kabsa area in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Yusef Abu Shihadeh (16 years old). • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli Police and Military stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 13:00, a demonstration took place in Jabal Al-Baba area in Al-Eizariya protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of settlement construction and expansion. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in

	<p>Abu Dis town.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. .</p>
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. • <u>Raid:</u> At 16:20, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 17:30. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and temporarily detained 2 children: Mahmoud Hamad (15 years old) and Raed Khalayleh (13 years old) then released them at 20:10. (ii) At 00:10, Israeli forces positioned at a Military watch tower located near the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh opened fire towards a vehicle which allegedly opened fire towards the Military post. • <u>Demonstrations:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:40, a demonstration took place in Bil’in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation and temporarily detained two International Peace Activists. (ii) At 13:40, a demonstration took place in Ni’lin protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result suffocated several residents from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 13:40, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against land confiscation for the purpose of Israeli settlement construction during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several demonstrators suffocating from tear gas inhalation.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 06:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ya’bad.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Far’a village until 12:30. (ii) At 20:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bardalah village until 21:15. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Tamoun, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home, temporarily detained Hamdan Bani Odeh and released him later then withdrew at 03:10.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) On August 5th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main steel gate and placed cement block along the road connecting Shufa and Izbit Shufa villages near “Aveni Hivits”. • Checkpoint: At 20:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Quffin junction. (ii) At 15:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Bazariya village junction located in east Anabta until 17:00.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 12:10 on September 2nd 2014, Israeli forces closed the road near Al-Nabi Eliyas village located along the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus with cement blocks. • Flying Checkpoint: At 15:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction, temporarily detained 2 residents including a Police officer: Safwan Barham (A Police officer) and Ahmad Barham the released them at 16:40. • Raid: At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Azzun until 04:15. • Demonstration: At 11:45, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces who tried to disrupt the demonstration and as a result left several demonstrators suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Dajjan village and set up a checkpoint at its entrance. (ii) At 22:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Bithan village until 23:00. • Temporary Detention: At 18:05, Israeli forces positioned near “Bargha”

	settlement temporally detained the child Wahib Qaddus (16 years old) {a resident of Iraq –Burin village then released him at 19:30.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 23:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Yasuf village until 00:15.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 09:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Aqbat Jabr camp in Jericho, summoned three residents: Ahmad Ibrahim, Imad Abu Zioena and Ahmad Al-Bad to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:20.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.

- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 10:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village (located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur) until 14:25.
 - (ii) At 16:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Taqou’.
 - **Raid:**
 - (i) At 17:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem and detained a resident after storming his home.
 - (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces raided Satih area located in east Beit Sahur, then stormed and searched several merchant shops.
 - (iii) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Taqou’, stormed a home, summoned Shadi Al-Amour to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:15.
 - (iv) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Shuwarat village, stormed a home summoned Ahmad Ishtayeh to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:15.
 - **Detention:**
 - (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned at the container checkpoint detained Yusef Masalmeh (A resident of Beit Awwa in Hebron).
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained Moath Abu Akr in Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem.
 - **Attack:**
 - (i) At 15:55, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned near “Murad Tunist Resort” located in North-East Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
 - **Demonstration:**
 - (i) At 13:50, a demonstration took place in Wadi Fuqin village protesting against Israeli land confiscation for the purpose of settlement construction during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and as a result left them suffocating from tear gas inhalation.
 - (ii) At 13:15, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma’sara village protesting against the construction of the wall during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades while preventing protesters from reaching the demonstration site.

<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) At 13:40 on September 16th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Ibrahim mosque in the old city of Hebron. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Thahiriya until 21:40. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Baraka area in Yatta then withdrew at 14:10. (ii) At 06:40, Israeli forces raided Hebron then stormed and searched a home. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 14:45, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained Mohammad Al-Natsheh (14 years old) then released him at a later time. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Shalashelh road located in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 18:35, Israeli forces positioned near Khursa village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> Since 08:00 on September 26th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gates leading to Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron in order to allow Israeli settler to perform Talmudic rituals.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents , students , tourists and businessmen (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
