JERUSALEM	Closure:  (i) The Israeli army continue to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City for Friday prayers.  (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.  (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.  Closure of Main Roads:  (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.  (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.  (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint.  Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.  Detention: On the morning of September 27th 2012, Israeli forces detained Saher Al Ghazawi inside Al-Aqsa mosque in the old city of Jerusalem.  Land Confiscation: On September 21th 2012, Israeli forces detained Saher Al Ghazawi inside Al-Aqsa mosque in the old city of Jerusalem.  Land Confiscation: On September 21th 2012, Israeli authorities approved the confiscation of 14 dunumes of land owned by Al-Sheikh and Shaker families under the pretext of being a closed military area.  Wall Gates:  (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.  (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villag

- Land Confiscation: Israeli authorities ordered the extension of land confiscation in Qalqiliya until December 31<sup>st</sup> 2014 which consist of the following land confiscation orders:
  - (i) **Land confiscation order T/07/06**, the confiscation of 9 dunumes of land in Kafr Lafiq for the installation military purposes and the installation of an Electric generator.
  - (ii) Land confiscation order T/21/91, the confiscation of 9 dunumes of land in Kafr Lafiq to pave a road connecting Karni Shomron and Janit Shomron settlements and bypass road #55.
  - (iii) **Land confiscation order T/22/95**, the confiscation of 31.5 dunumes of land in Qalqiliya in order to pave a road connecting Tsufin settlement
  - (iv) Land confiscation order T/21/95, the confiscation of 4.5 dunumes of land in Jit village to pave a road connecting Kadumim settlement with bypass road #55.
  - (v) **Land confiscation order T/17/03**, the confiscation of 1.4 dunumes of land in Azzun to pave a road connecting military base with by pass road # 55
  - (vi) **Land confiscation order T/02/86**, the confiscation of 1.4 dunumes of land in Kafr Jamal for the purpose of installing a military base.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Oaryut.
- <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 08:15 and again at 20:00, Israeli forces increased its restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 20:45.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 12:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Rujib village junction until 12:40.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 18:40, Israeli forces raided Salem village, clashed with residents then withdrew at 20:40.
- (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces raided Jamma'in village, clashed with residents, detained and interrogated several residents including Sanad Zitawi (17 years) then withdrew at 20:00.
- (iii) At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Balata camp in Nablus, fired tear gas and stun grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 08:15, Israeli forces positioned at Huwwara checkpoint temporarily detained and interrogated Qassim Al-Tirabi, a resident of

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Taqou' until 11:45.
- (ii) At 12:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar and stormed a steel mill.
- (iii) At 12:25, Israeli forces raided Dar Salah village and stormed a vehicle repair shop.
- Land Confiscation: On September 18<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces served a confiscation order to confiscate 60 dunums of land owned by Sabri Manasra and Jum'a Assaf in Wadi Fuqin village.

#### • Settler Violence:

- (i) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli settler confiscated and installed tents on 6 dunumes of land in Al-Khadr owned by Ali Salah and his sons.
- (ii) At 14:40, an Israeli settler vehicle rammed Amjad Sa'd (14 years) leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
- (iii) On September 27<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli settlers pumped sewage waste on agricultural land in Fuqin village and flooded 50 dunumes of agricultural land.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Yatta and Khilat Al-Miya.

#### • Raids:

- (i) At 18:15, Israeli forces raided Suba village.
- (ii) At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Tabaqa village, clashed with residents as they stormed several homes, assaulted Amin Atawn leaving him hospitalised with contusions and detained 2 residents.
- (iii) At 01:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou', stormed a home then withdrew
