- On September 27th 2013 Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Raid:** At 16:10, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and clashed with several residents.

• Attack:

- (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Nablus road in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents including Samiya Abu Sneienh and detained 2 residents.
- (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned Qalandiya checkpoint, fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning
- (iii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets and tears gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents: Ahmad Oday, Yazan Idris and Baha

JERUSALEM

- Hamad leaving them hospitalised with contusions.
- (iv) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at Bab Hata and Wadi Al-Joz neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets and tears gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (v) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at the Wall gate in Al-Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets and tears gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents.
- (vi) At 21:40, Israeli forces positioned at Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets and tears gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- (vii)At 22:00, Israeli forces in Al-Thuri neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets and tears gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.

• <u>Detention:</u>

- (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al Amoud neighbourhood detained 2 children: Mohammad Al Atrash (15 years old) and Yusef Al-Atrash.
- (ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem detained 8 residents including 2 children: Firas Karkour (17 years old), Mohammad Karkor (16 years old), Ma'moun Dweik, Mohammad Salim, Diya Yusef, Isam Yusef, Mohammad Saman and Suhayb Al-Rajabi.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Shalabi and Ismail Al-Shweiki along Nablus road in Jerusalem.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood temporarily detained Mohammad Tarha (Palestine Television Reporter) then released him at a later time.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.
- (iii) Since 24:00 on September 24th 2013, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gate leading to "Bet El" Settlement which leads to Al-Jalazun camp main road.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atara bridge until 15:30.
- Raid: At 18:55, Israeli forces raided Deir Jrier, set up a checkpoint then withdrew at 19:40.

Attack:

(i) At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Ofar prison fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents including a child: Qusay Jabran (14 years old) and Ahmad Id'is.

(iii) At 16:40, Israeli forces positioned near Budrus village fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. 	coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 19:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Azzun and Izbat Al-Tabib village, detained a child, temporarily detained 2 residents including a child: Othman Tabib (14 years old) and Thaer Tabib releasing them at 20:35.
- (ii) At 19:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun, impeded the free flow of traffic after closing the steel gate then reopened it at 08:00.
- (iii) At 19:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Azzun bridge until 07:50.

• Raid:

- (i) At 08:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Jit village, occupied the home of Jamal Arram and converted it into a military post until 09:15.
- (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum village, clashed with its residents then withdrew at 14:45.
- (iii) At 19:20, Israeli forces raided Azzun, clashed with residents as they stormed a home, injured 2 residents: Ahmad Salama and Oday Hussin leaving them hospitalised with contusions and detained a resident.

• Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Abdallah Bata (14 years old) in the area between Azzun and Izbat Al-Tabib village.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Salim in Azzun.

• Attack:

- (i) At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned near the Wall gate in south Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 18:10, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and fired tear gas grenades towards a Palestinian National Security vehicle positioned nearby and as a result causing them to withdraw suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
- <u>Demonstration</u>: At 11:30, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the continued closure of the village east entrance and demanding the reopening of the entrance during which clashed erupted between demonstrators and Israeli forces and prevented demonstrators from reaching the protest site set fire to 15 Olive tress after a tear gas grenade canister fired by Israeli forces exploded and left several others suffocating from tear gas inhalation.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction was continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 14:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Wadi Al-Juz area located at the entrance of Bani Na'im.

- (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Shalashla road in the old city of Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 children: Fadi Al-Natsheh(16 years old) and Khaldoun Dajjana (14 years old) leaving them hospitalised with contusions..
- (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 15 residents including a child: Mus'ab Ismail (5 years old) leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
- (iii)At 15:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Huwar area located in North Halhul fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents: Thaer Madiya and Qusay Zamar'a leaving them hospitalised

with contusions.

(iv)At 18:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents: Qusay Abu Hisham and Yusef Sabarna leaving them hospitalised with contusions.

• Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. Israeli military broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Gaza. Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching projectiles towards the Green Line.
NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. Palestinian Attack: On the evening of September 27th 2013, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Attack: At 13:30, Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades from their positions behind the Green Line several demonstrators' protesting Israeli settlers attacks on Al-Aqsa mosque compound and as a result left 5 demonstrators' suffocating from tear gas inhalation.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (<i>Al</i> 'Awdah) Crossing is closed. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
