JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 08:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba’ checkpoint located along the main road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a check point in Jabal Al-Tur neighbourhood and assaulted Firas Al-Daya leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned at Shu’fat checkpoint fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 14:40, Israeli positioned at Al-Ram junction fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 15:30, Israeli positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 22:00, Israeli positioned at the entrance of Al-Amoud gate in the old city of Jerusalem fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> At 16:30 on September 27th2013, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem detained Tawfiq Saleem (13 years old). • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> On September 28th 2013, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Hadid Gate in the old city of Jerusalem temporarily detained Sabrin Thiyab (a journalist) and released her after questioning her at an Israeli Police station. • <u>Home Occupation:</u> On September 28th 2013, Israeli forces served several home occupation notices for several homes in A-Sa'adeh neighbourhood on the old city of Jerusalem in order to convert their rooftops into military posts. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli settlers assaulted Ghada Abu Rmelieh (13 years old) and Thikra Abu Rmeleh (13 years old) as they were heading to school in the old city of Jerusalem leaving them hospitalised with contusions. (ii) At dawn on September 29th 2013, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Sheikh Jarrah neighbourhood and damaged 8 vehicles. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim for Sabbath holiday.

(ii) At 09:35, on September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Aboud and detained a resident. (ii) At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash'al village until 22:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 22:35 and again at 01:00, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 01:40. • <u>Attack:</u> At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Ofar prison fired tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Samir Barghouthi in Aboud. (ii) Israeli forces detained Bakr Al-Aroui and Mohammad Eid • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages for Sabbath holiday.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 07:35, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Movo Dotan" checkpoint located in south Ya'bad and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 06:10, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad and fired stun grenades. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Detention:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located on the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and detained Riyad Daoud (a Police officer). • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Deir Al-Ghusun temporarily detained Thaer Thiyab and released him at 11:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Jayyus and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Sameh Samaha in Jayyus. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector and at 24:00 impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction was halted in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement for Sabbath holiday.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:55, Israeli forces raided Jamma’in village until 11:40 (ii) At 19:15, Israeli forces raided Osarin village, clashed with its residents and as a result suffocated 4 residents including a woman from tear gas inhalation. (iii) At 00:35, Israeli forces raided Balata and Asqar camps, clashed with

(ii) Israeli forces detained Raed Khadr in Deir Sharaf village.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement for Sabbath holiday.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:20 and again at 12:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho. (ii) At 08:55 and again at 12:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nue'meh village junction along road (90) until 14:40. (iii) At 10:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nabi Musa area junction located along the main road connecting Jericho and Jerusalem • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village. (ii) At 16:25, Israeli forces raided Fasayil village.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Ayda camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 09:50, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Container checkpoint temporarily detained 3 residents Yunis Arar, Yusef Abu Mariya and Rateb Al-Jabour (all residents of Hebron) and released them at 21:00. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 21:20, an Israeli settler ran over Hadan Thitab with his vehicle leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction was halted in North West of Beit Jala town for Sabbath holiday. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village

which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bani Na'im.
 - (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Hebron.
 - (iii) At 14:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Kahil until 16:05.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces raided Khilat Abu Bayda area in Bani Na'im and stormed several homes.
 - (ii) On the evening of September 28th 2013, Israeli forces raided Safaa village, fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result left 2 children: Ahmad Abu Daya (2 years old) and Aws Abu Daya (5 years old) suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
 - (iii) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 03:25.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Huwar area located at the north entrance of Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Home Occupation:** At 09:35, Israeli forces occupied Ramal Saders home located at Al-Shuhada road in the old city of Hebron and converted its rooftop into a military post.
- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction was halted in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town for Jewish holiday.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> • Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry of residents and tourists. • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
