### Closure: The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem (i) city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (ii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. **Checkpoints:** (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Oalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of **JERUSALEM** Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. Raid: At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, demolished a home consisting of five floors owned by Dr. Mutasim Adilah for allegedly being built without a licence during which clashed erupted between residents and Israeli forces then withdrew at 04:30. **Assault on Places of Worship:** Since the morning of September 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Agsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem. **Wall Gates:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. **Closure of Main Roads:** RAMALLAH & (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as AL BIREH

# ALL DISTRICTS

- At 19:00 on August 26<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza and as a result injured a resident

# NORTHERN GAZA

- <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
- <u>Attack:</u> On September 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several farmers in North Beit Lahiya and as a result injured Rajab Marouf.

## GAZA

### **Closure of Crossing Points:**

- (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
- (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.

## RAFAH

### • Closure of Crossing Points :

- (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed.
- (ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents , students , tourists and businessmen
- (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed.
- (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
