JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Mukhmas village.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> At 06:00 on September 29<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained Omar Al-Sharawi after storming his home in the old city of Jerusalem.</li> <li>• <b><u>Physical Assault:</u></b> On September 29<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces assaulted and injured two journalists: Ahmad Jallajil and Dalia Juwahin in Jerusalem.</li> <li>• <b><u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u></b> Since the morning of September 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 01:30, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces occupied 26 Apartments in 10 buildings and several other separate homes in Silwan neighbourhood after forcibly removing the residents living in them including: Anan Bayoud, Yusef Zawahra, Adel Khayat, Nabil Al-Karaki, Jihad Kara’in and Faysal Al-Karaki.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<p><b>QALQILIYA</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.</li> <li>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</li> <li>(iii) At 12:10 on September 2<sup>nd</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Qalqiliya and Nablus near Al-Nabi Eliyas village with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum, stormed and searched seven homes then withdrew at 04:00.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>SALFIT</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</li> <li>(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.</li> <li>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Harris village until 18:30.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Salfit, clashed with several residents as they stormed two homes and summoned Salim Abu Shama to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 01:55.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>JERICHO</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 09:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-New’meh village located at the North entrance of Jericho until 09:40.</li> <li>(ii) At 09:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 10:40.</li> <li>(iii) At 10:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction until 10:40.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Physical Assault:</u></b> At 19:20, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge assaulted Mohammad Tahlawi (50 years old) {A resident of Tulkarem} as he was returning from Jordan and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>BETHLEHEM</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</li> <li>(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

- **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 11:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Khiliyat Al-Louz village, occupied the home of Raed Abiyat and converted its rooftop into a Military post and temporarily detained Rami Ba'lousheh then released him later and withdrew at 14:00.
- (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur until 17:30.
- (iii) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar until 01:20.
- (iv) At 20:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Za'tara until 22:25.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 12:05, Israeli forces raided Wadi Al-Nis village located in South Bethlehem served military orders to demolish 7 homes owned by Salah Abu Hamad, Saed Abu Hamad, Mohammad Abu Hamad, Osama Abu Hamad, Hassan Abu Hamad, Nasri Abu Hamad and Nur Abu Hamad for allegedly being built without proper licencing.
- (ii) At 17:55, Israeli forces raided Taqou', clashed with several residents as they stormed a home, temporarily detained Mohammad Abu Mifrih and released him at a later time then withdrew at 19:10.
- (iii) At 20:40, Israeli forces raided the village of Hrmala, and temporary detained Ala' Asakra released him after at 22:10.
- (iv) At 01:40, Israeli forces raided the area located near the entrance of Husan village, stormed several homes and detained two residents.
- (v) At dawn on September 30<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces raided Irtas village and detained a resident after storming and searching his home.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</li> <li>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. <p style="text-align: center;"><b>ALL DISTRICTS</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At 19:00 on August 26<sup>th</sup> 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.</li> <li>• Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by raiding and opening fire toward Gaza.</li> <li>• Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards North Gaza and as a result injured a resident</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>NORTHERN GAZA</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Crossing Point:</b> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.</li> <li>• <b>Attack:</b> At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several workers in North Um Al-Nassr village located North Beit Lahiya and as a result injured the child Jallal Jarrad (14 years old).</li> </ul>

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.</li> <li>(ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> On the morning of September 29<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces, Military tanks and fighter jets escorting several military bulldozer into the area located in east Al-Zaytouneh neighbourhood located in south east Gaza and levelled a plot of land.</li> </ul>
