JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Since 18:00 on September 27th 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:25, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis until 04:00. (ii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Hizma village, stormed several homes and detained six residents. (iii) At dawn on September 30th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and detained 4 residents. • <u>Attack:</u> At 19:35, Israeli forces positioned near Ras Al-Kabsa village junction located in Abu Dis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:30, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on September 29th 2015, Israeli forces detained 3 residents including a child: Abed Mohammad Owisat (17 years old), Khaled Owisat and Mohammad Owisat in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (ii) At dawn on September 29th 2015, Israeli forces detained four residents: Obada Najib, Mohammad Najib, Rami Al-Fakhouri and Layth Ghayth in the old city of Jerusalem. (iii) At 15:30, Israeli forces detained Jihad Qous in the old city of Jerusalem. (iv) At dawn on September 30th 2015, Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Akram Husana, Yusef Abu Maliya, Musa Abu Maliya and Mohammad Abu Gharbiya in Silwan neighbourhood. (v) Israeli forces detained six residents: Abdallah Askar, Mohammad Al-Omari, Ramez Kan’an, Malik Askar, Hamada Abu Khalil and Mohammad Askar in Hizma village. (vi) Israeli forces detained four residents: Ayoub Abu Assab, Sari Mahmoud, Ahmad Mahmoud and Yusef Darwish in Al-Eisawiya village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • Checkpoint: At 14:30, Israeli forces closed Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near Bet El settlement in North Al-Bireh city and impeded the free flow of traffic during which confrontations erupted between Israeli forces and residents then reopened it later. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Liqya, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 21:15. (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ibzi’ village, detained a Police officer then withdrew at 03:00. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on September 29th 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Rima, stormed and searched several homes and detained two residents then confiscated a hunting rifle. (ii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Bir Zeit, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 04:10. • Attack: At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near Bet El settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards residents(who protesting the continued Israeli settler and Israeli Military attacks on Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem) for alleged stoning and as a result injured 6 residents including a child: Zayed Abu Hamad (16 years old), Ahmad Hajir, Jum’a Snief, Ahmad Al-Taweel, Hazem Nassar and Mohammad Azmi (who was also detained). • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Taysir Musa and Mohammad Assi at the entrance of Beit Liqya. (ii) Israeli forces detained Jamil Mansour near the entrance of Deir Ibzi’ village. (iii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Adli Taha and Mohammad Shukri Mohammad in Beit Rima. (iv) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Fadi Hamad and Shuja’ Darwish in Bir Ziet. (v) Israeli forces positioned at Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near Bet El settlement in North Al-Bireh city detained Mohammad Azmi (After he was injured).
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • Raid: At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad until 03:00. • Settler Violence: At 11:15, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Anin, Tinik and Rumana villages during which Israeli forces fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents who attempted to prevent the settler attack near Rumana village then withdrew at 18:20. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.

<p style="text-align: center;">TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 12:30. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Allar junction until 12:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces raided Attil. (ii) At 23:45, Israeli forces raided Shufa village until 00:30. (iii) At 03:25, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, detained a residents after storming and searching his home then withdrew at 05:05. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Yahya Mughimeir in Tulkarem. • <u>Attack:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity of Ishouri Factory area located in West Tulkarem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (who protesting the continued Israeli settler and Israeli Military attacks on Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem) for alleged stoning.
<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village, which is located near “Gillad” settlement with a steel Gate. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:10, Israeli forces raided Azzoun, fired stun grenades towards residents then fired flash grenades into the sky of the east section of the area. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p style="text-align: center;">NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Deir Sharaf village junction located along the main road connecting Nablus and Tulkarem until 10:15. (ii) At 09:05 and again at 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beir Furiq until 19:15. (iii) At 09:05 and again at 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Beit Dajjan village junction until 19:00. • <u>Raid:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:50, Israeli forces raided Subastiya village as they escorted a group of Israeli settlers to archaeological sites. (ii) At 22:15, Israeli forces raided Tel village, temporarily detained 5 residents including a Palestinian Intelligence officer: Akrama Zidan (a Palestinian Intelligence officer), Nour Al-Din Zidan, Issam Ghanam and Mahmoud Ghannam then released them at a later time and again at 04:05 Israeli forces raided the village and fired tear gas grenades towards Jamal Yamens home, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:30. (iii) At 23:10, Israeli forces raided Kafr Kalil village until 05:30. (iv) At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Madma village and detained a resident as the stormed a home. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Waleed Assaydeh in Tel village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Adel-Karim Ziyadah in Madma village. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 16:50, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Fakhim area near Aqraba temporarily detained four residents: Attah Maniya, Mohammad Bani Jaber, Raed Bani Jaber and Ahmad Madaniya as they were herding their goats and released them later.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 18:10, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 20:25. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qarwat Bani Hassan. • <u>Detention:</u> At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint detained Majd Kataneh (A resident of Quffin in Tulkarem).
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.

Bethlehem

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
 - (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
 - (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
 - (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
 - (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
 - (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
 - (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
 - (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
 - (ix) At 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amoush" settlement with dirt mounds.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 11:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah Village Bridge located at the east entrance of Beit Sahour until 14:30.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 12:20, Israeli forces raided Husan village, temporarily detained several school children near their school then released them at 13:00.
 - (ii) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, detained 2 residents including a National Security Force Officer).
 - (iii) At 06:55, Israeli forces raided Beit Sahour then stormed and searched a building.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) On September 27th 2015, Israeli forces detained Taha Hathalin as he was herding his sheep near Al-Jub'a village.
 - (ii) Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Balboul and Abdel-Hafath Raba in Bethlehem.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 12:15, Israeli forces positioned near the north entrance of Taqou' fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and

	<p>occupied 2 homes owned by Awad Suliman and Issa Al-Sha'ir and converted their rooftops into Military posts.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• At 13:05, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mahmoud Haddad.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Closure:<ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

HEBRON

 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
 - (vi) At 11:00 on August 6th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Hajara village located in south Dura with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up six checkpoints at the entrances of Bani Na'im, Sa'ir, and Tarqumiya, Bani Ainoun village, Al-Natsha area, near Jabal Johar area in the old city of Hebron and at the North entrance of Hebron.
 - (ii) At 11:25 and again at 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhoul Bridge until 19:00.
- **Attack:**
 - (i) At 12:45, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Hwar area located at the North entrance of Halhoul and near the entrances of Aroub and Al-Fuwar, camps fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (ii) At 13:20, Israeli forces positioned in Bab Al-Zawiya area in Hebron fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (iii) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Fahs area located in South Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
 - (iv) At 21:15, Israeli forces positioned near Tarik Bin Zied junction in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **Temporary Detention:** At 17:20, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Baraka area located in Yatta temporarily detained Basil Shawahin (12 years old) then released him later.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:** On September 29th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Ibrahimi mosque compound in the old city of Hebron and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers inside the mosque in order to allow Israeli settlers to perform Talmudic rituals inside the mosque in celebration of the Jewish Holiday.
- **Settler Violence:**
 - (i) At 08:45, a group of Israeli settlers stormed the old city of Hebron and chased 3 school girls as they were walking to school and as a result injured the child Nadin Al-Salaymeh (11 years old) after she fell down while running away from the settlers leaving her hospitalised with a fractured arm.
 - (ii) At 10:40, a group of Israeli settlers prevented several residents from accessing a water well in Ain Al-Far'a area in Dura.
 - (iii) At 12:25, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near "Talmin" settlement located in Tarqumiya stoned vehicles travelling along the bypass road(35) leading to Tarqumiya crossing.

(ii) At 02:45, Israeli Military jets launched a missile towards a Palestinian gunman-training base in Al-Sudaniya area located in West Beit Lahiya. • Palestinian Attack: At 22:45, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.
